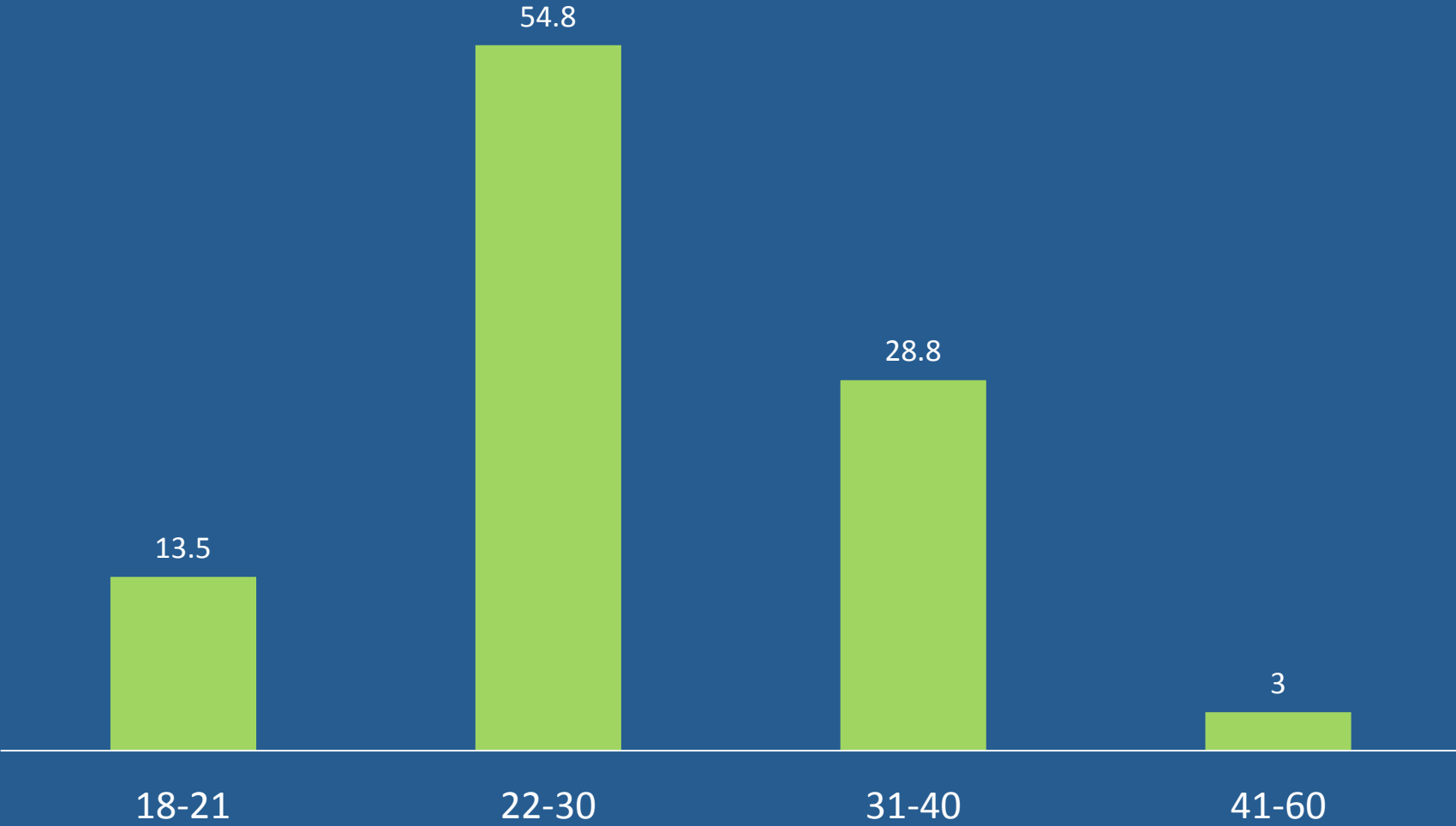

- 100 Interviews with ex-combatants in Turkey and inside Syria from various Islamist brigades (Nov-Dec 2014)

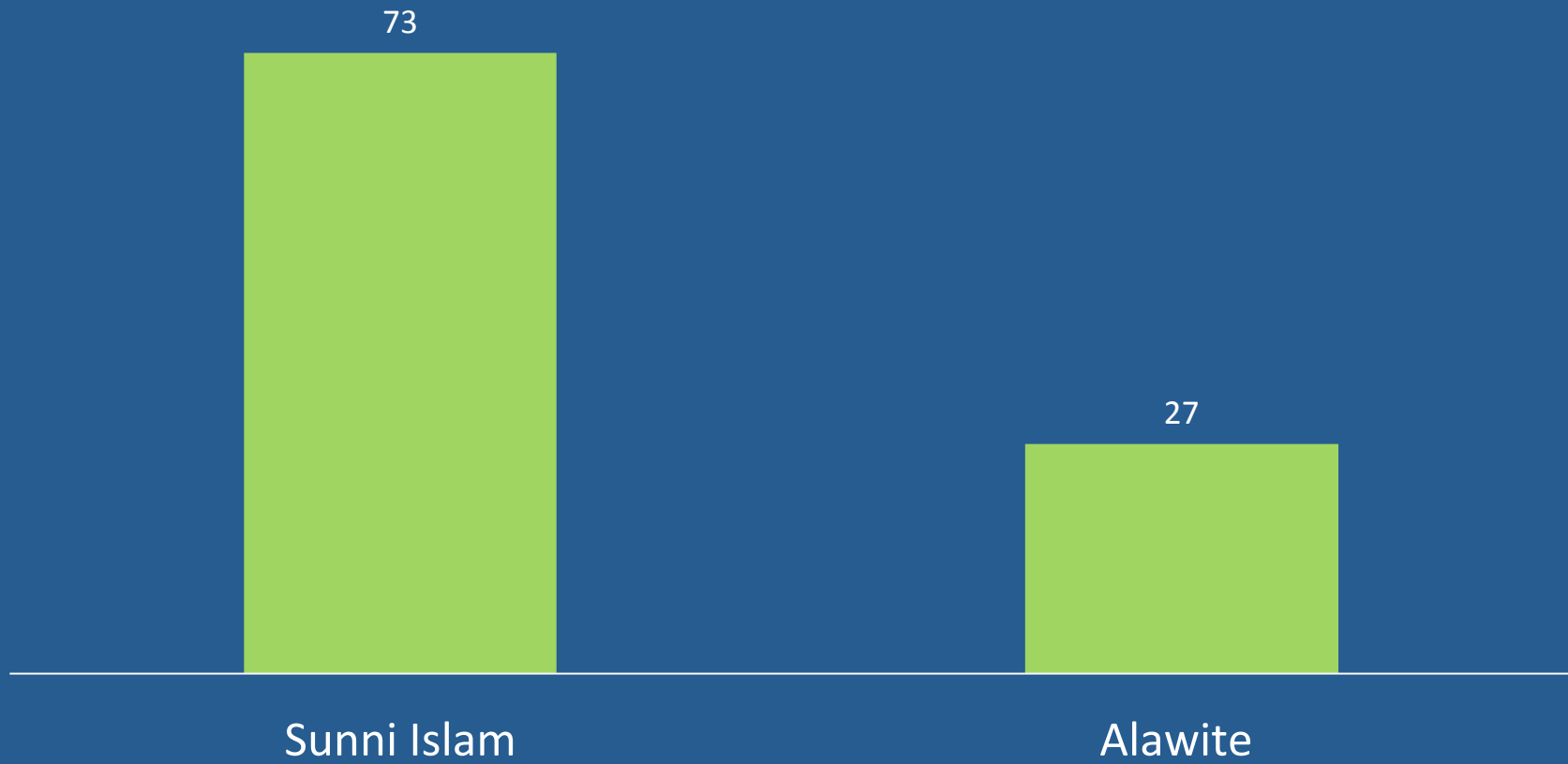

Respondent Age Group



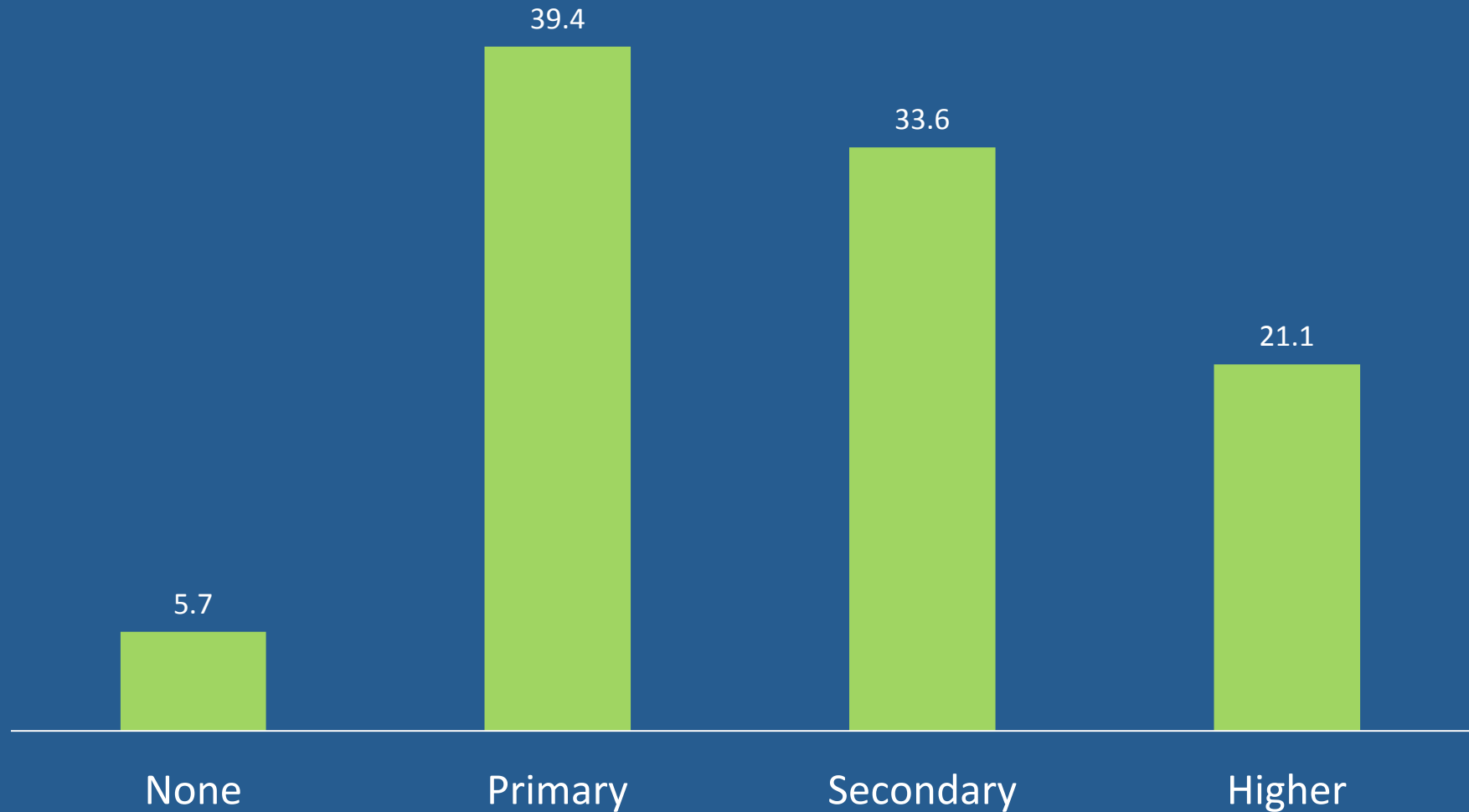

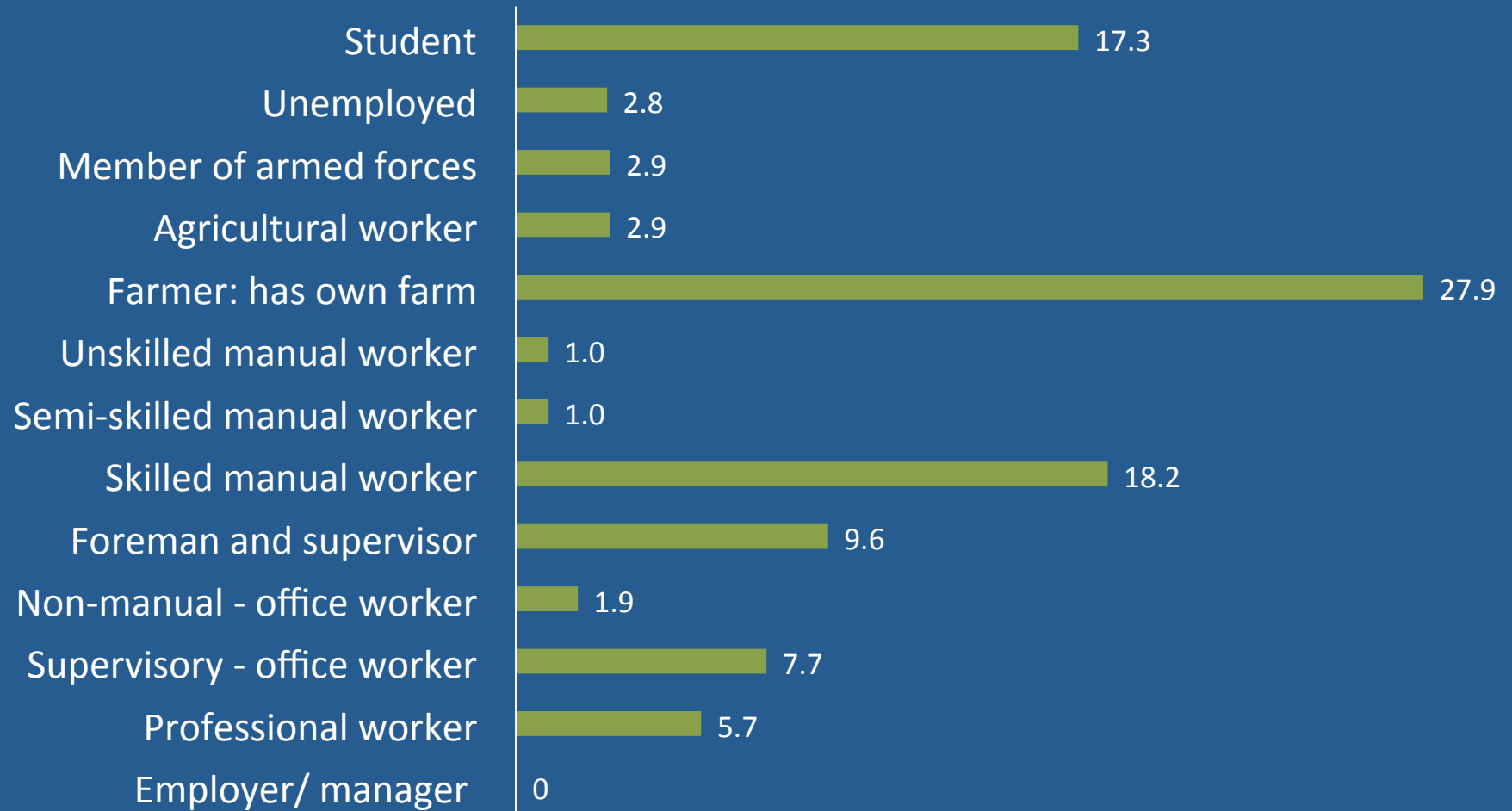
Respondent Education Levels

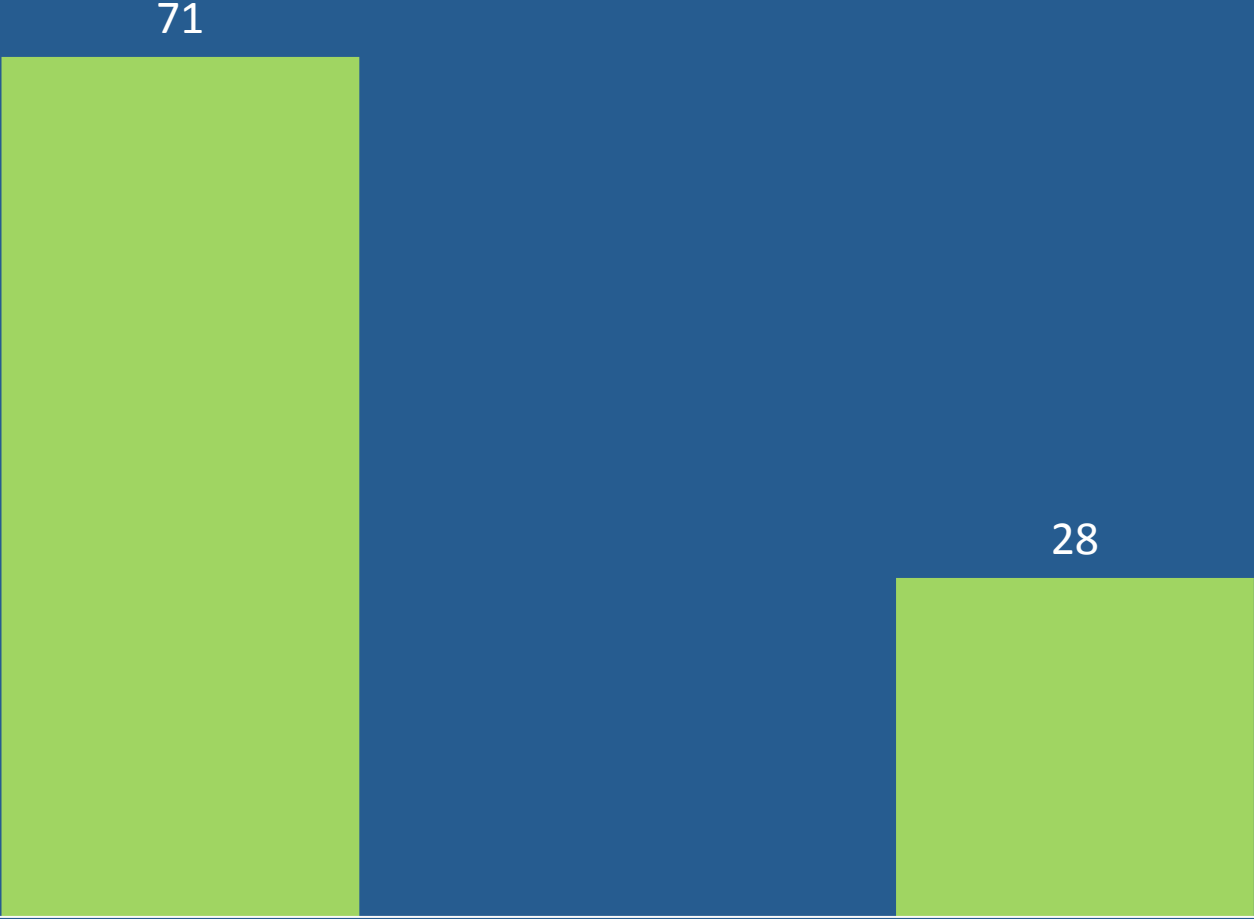

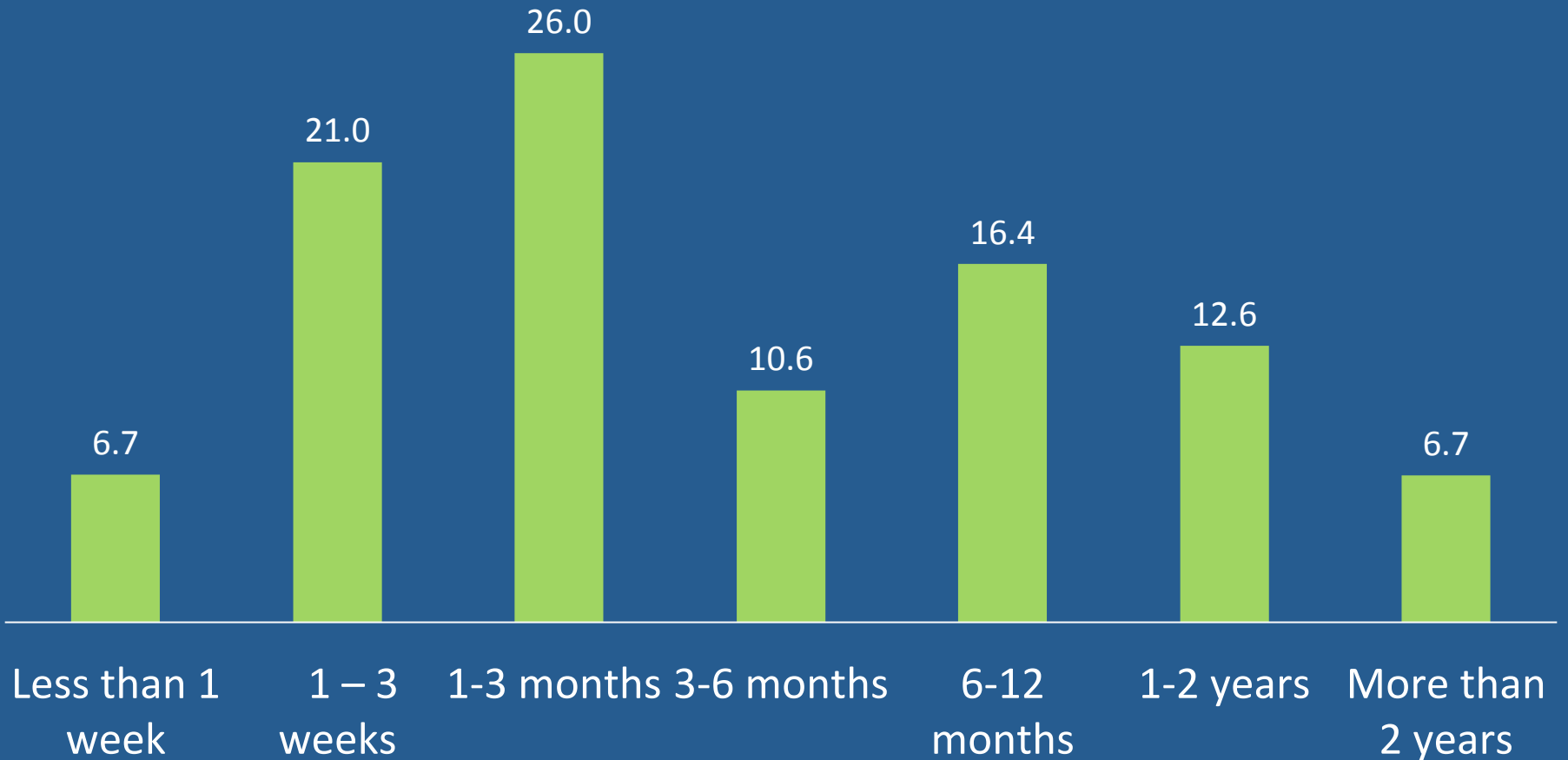

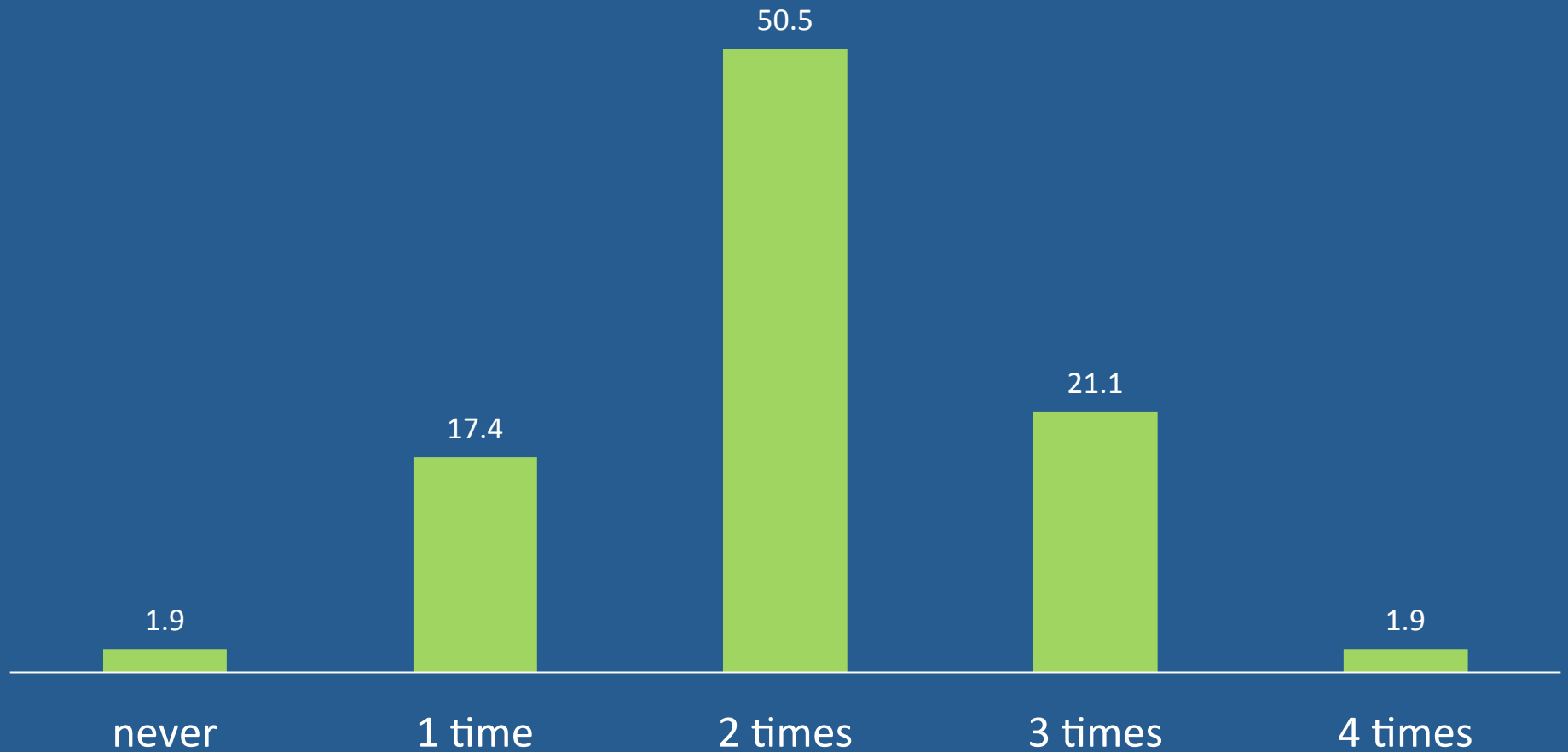
Time in Current Location

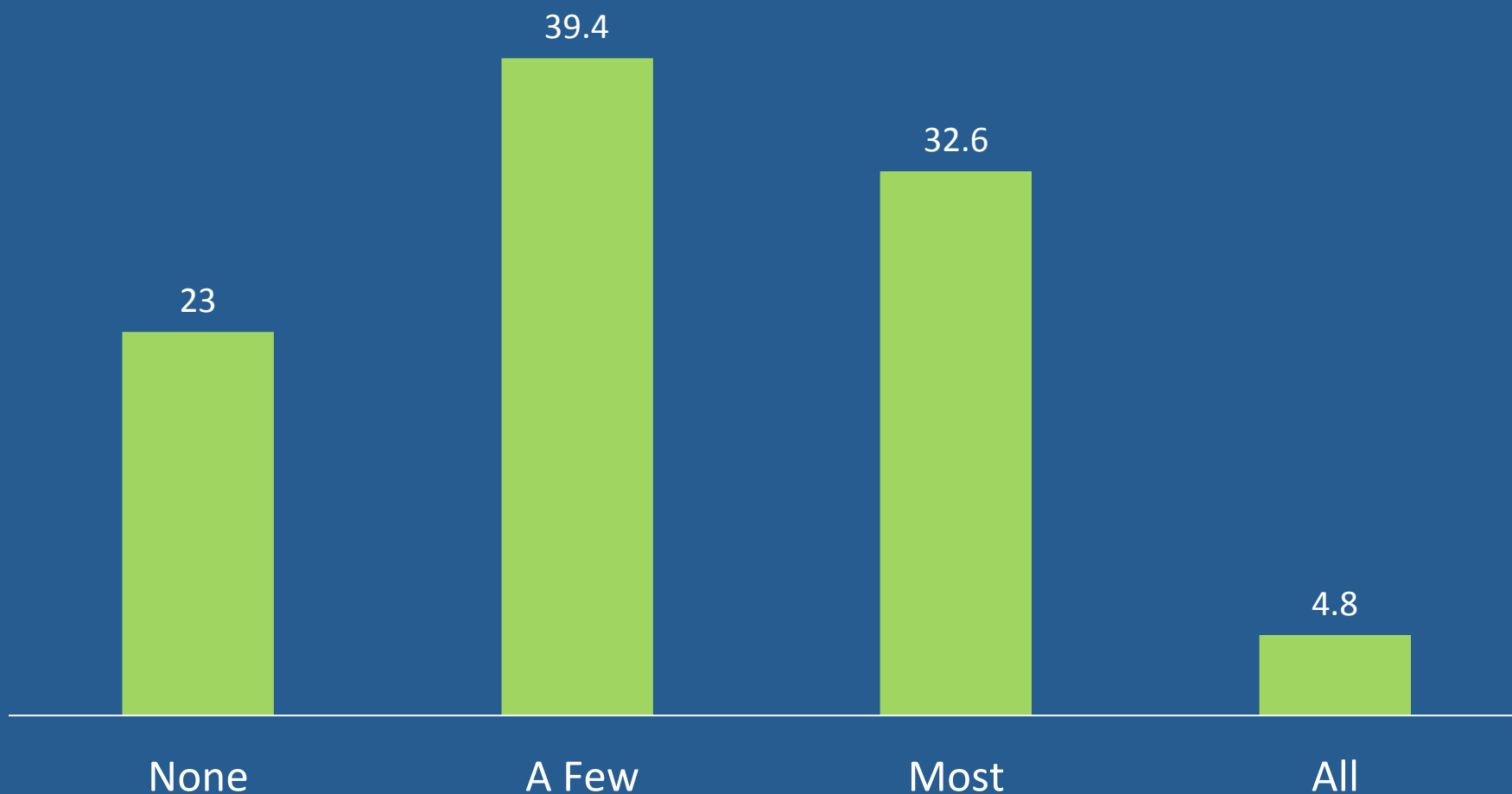
Displacement by Conflict

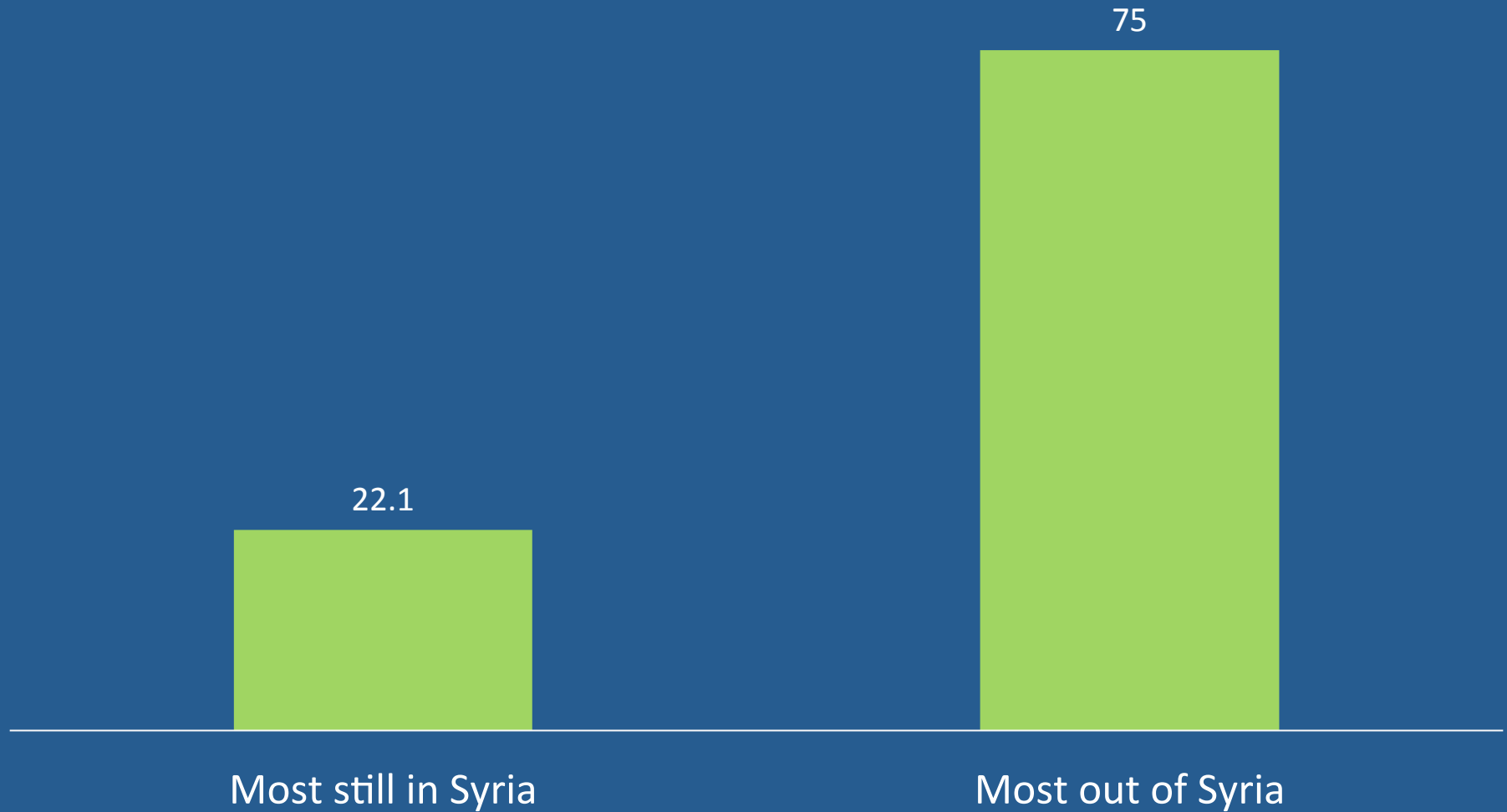

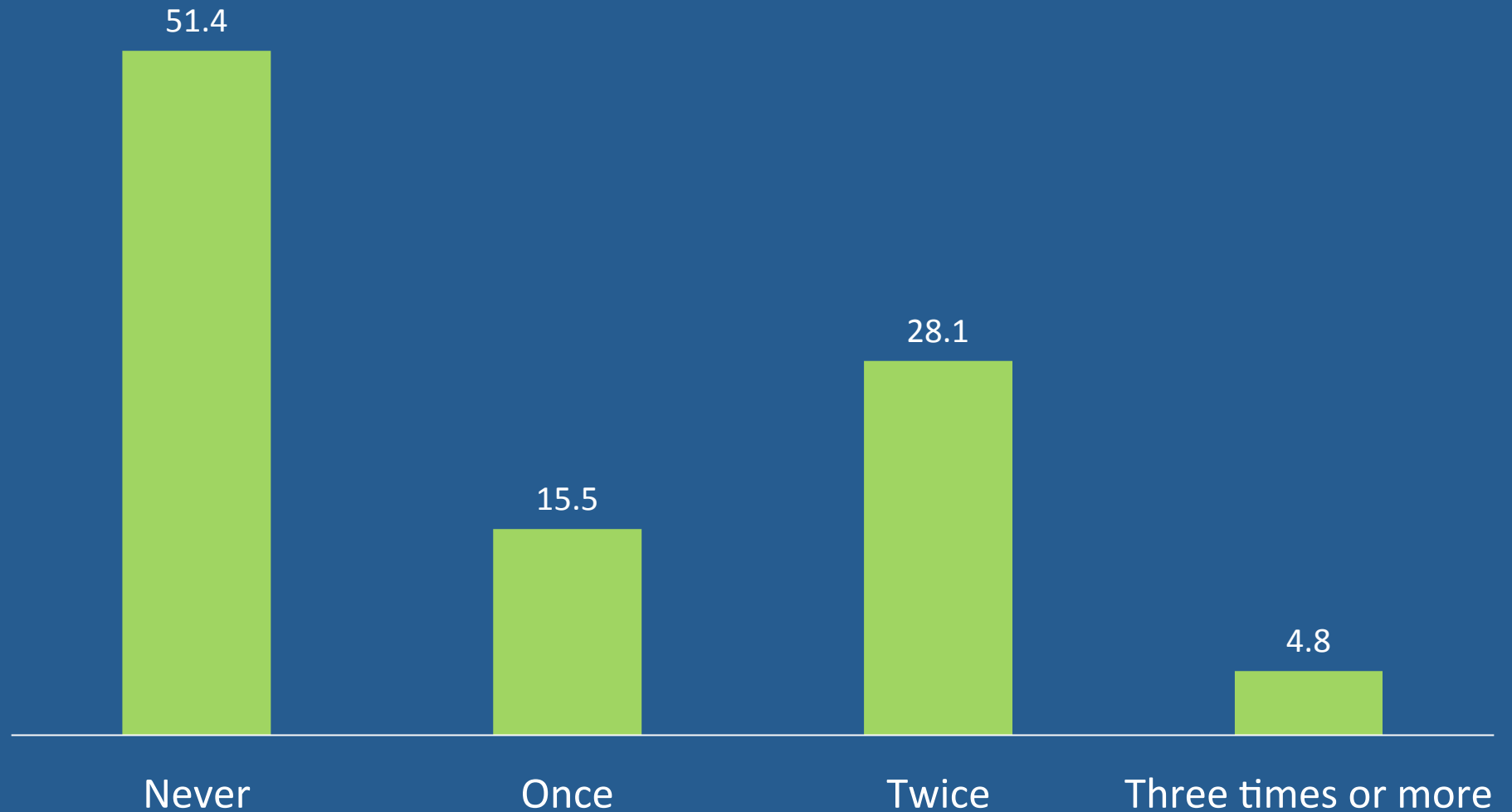
Displacement of Family Members

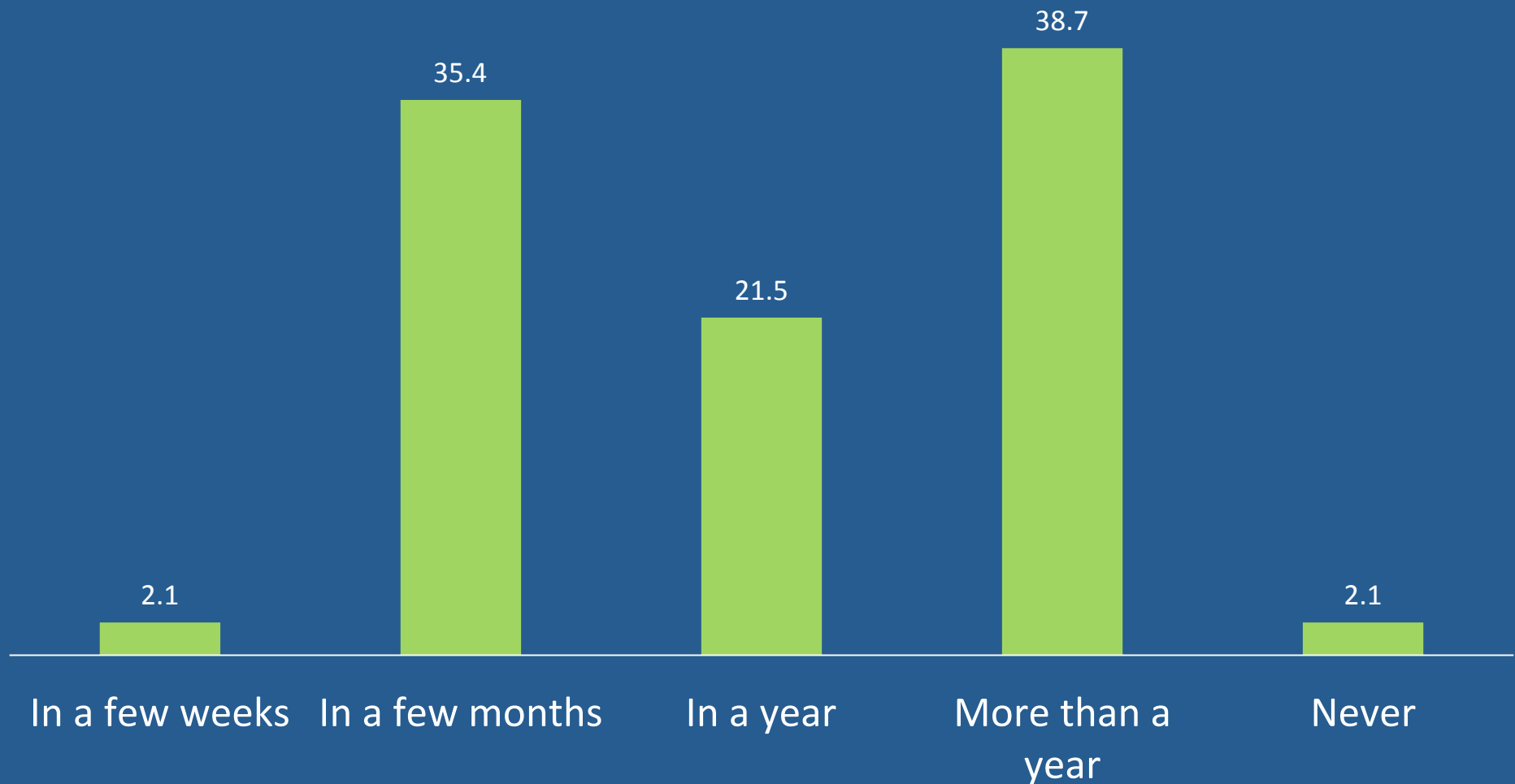

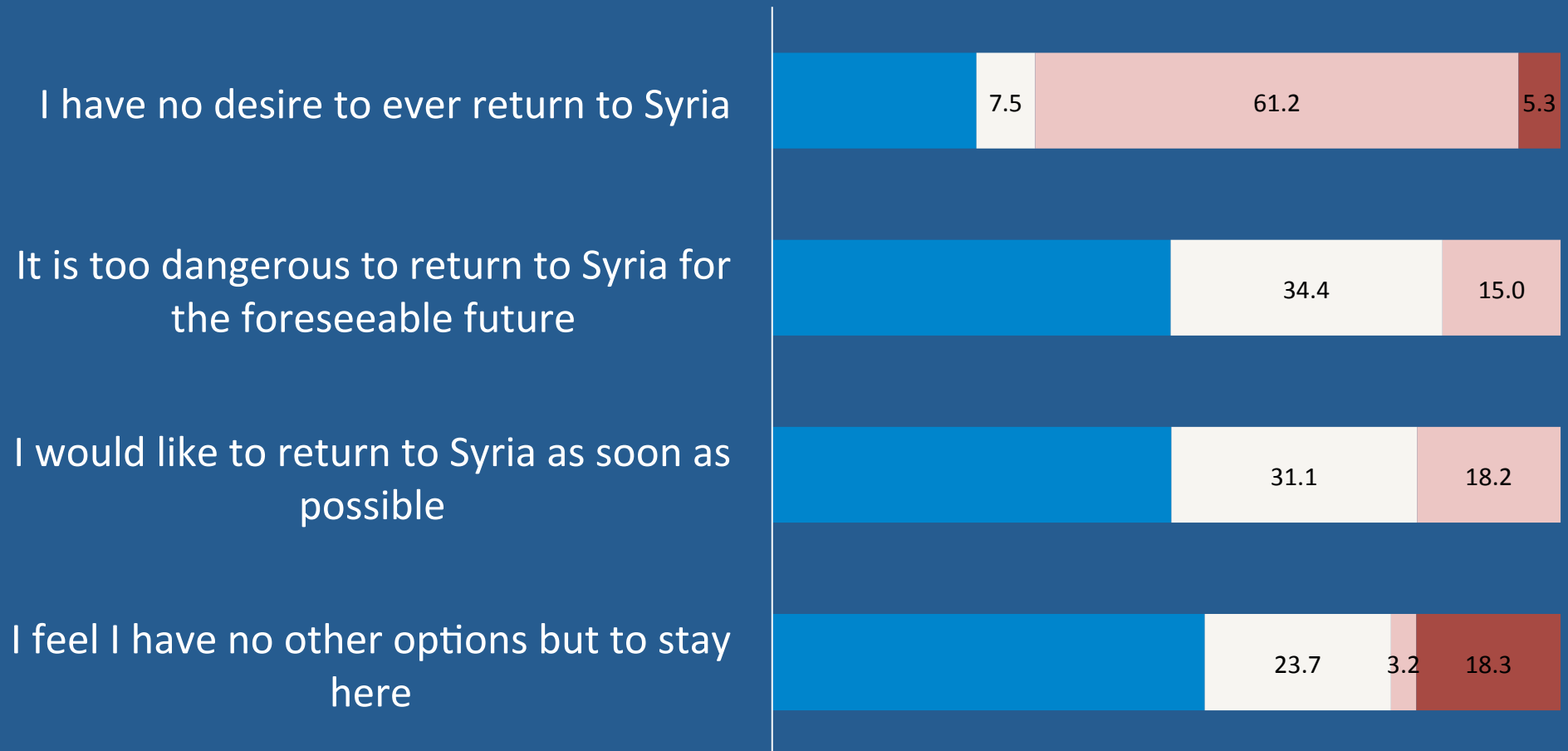

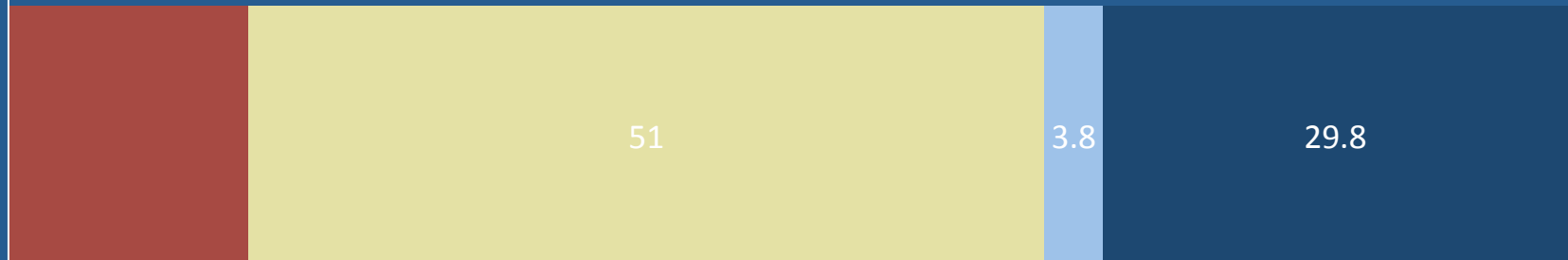

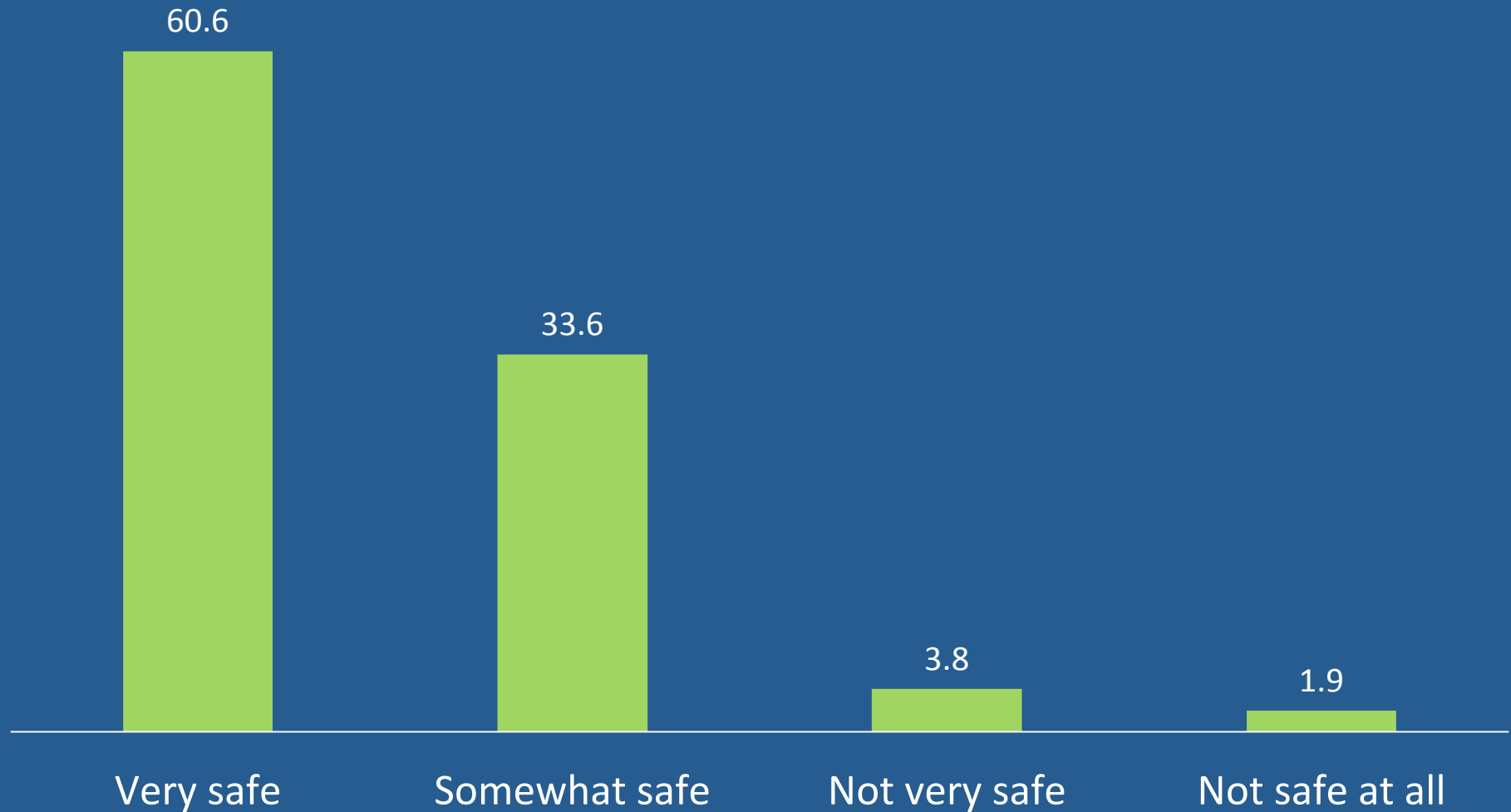

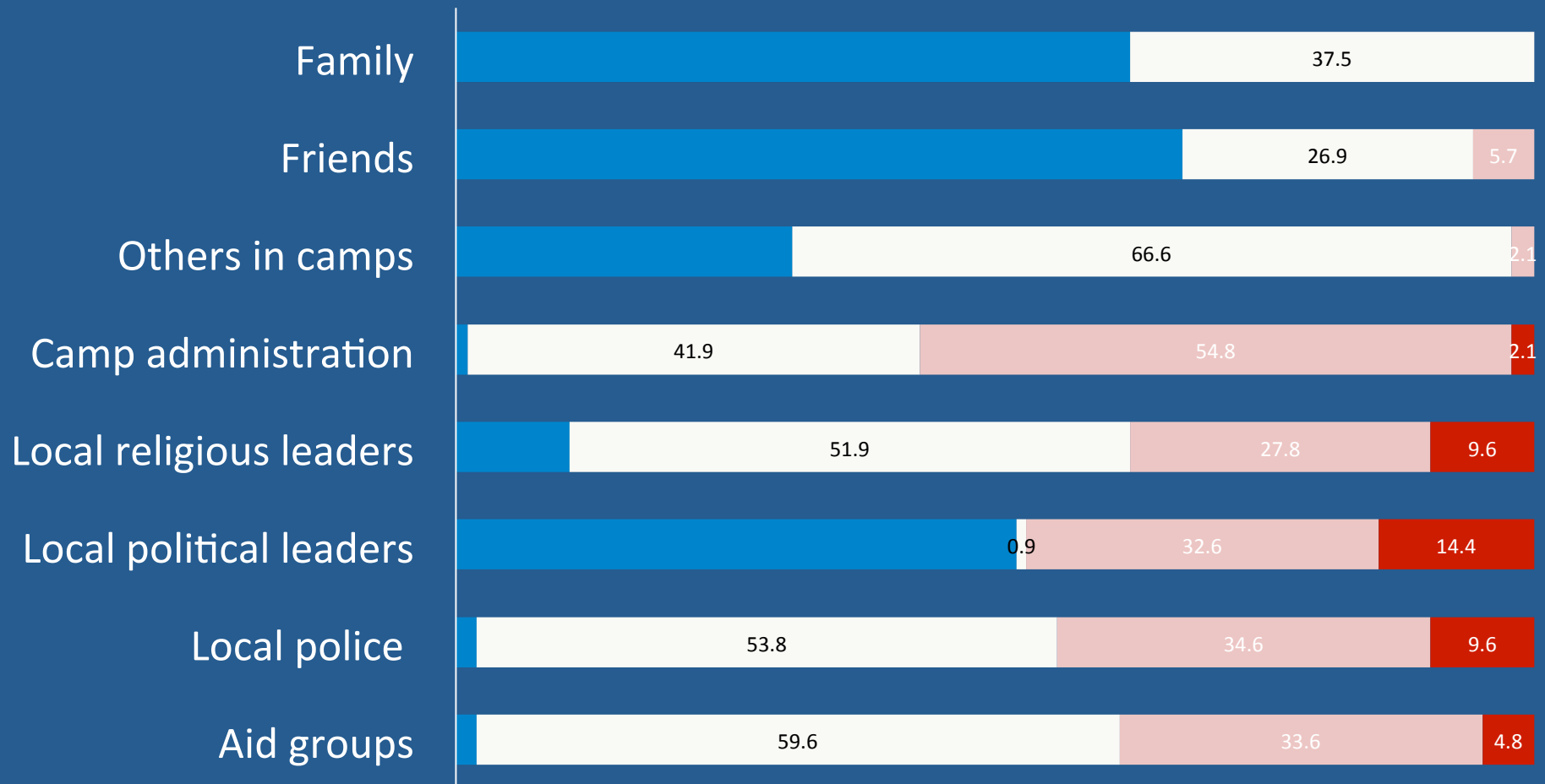

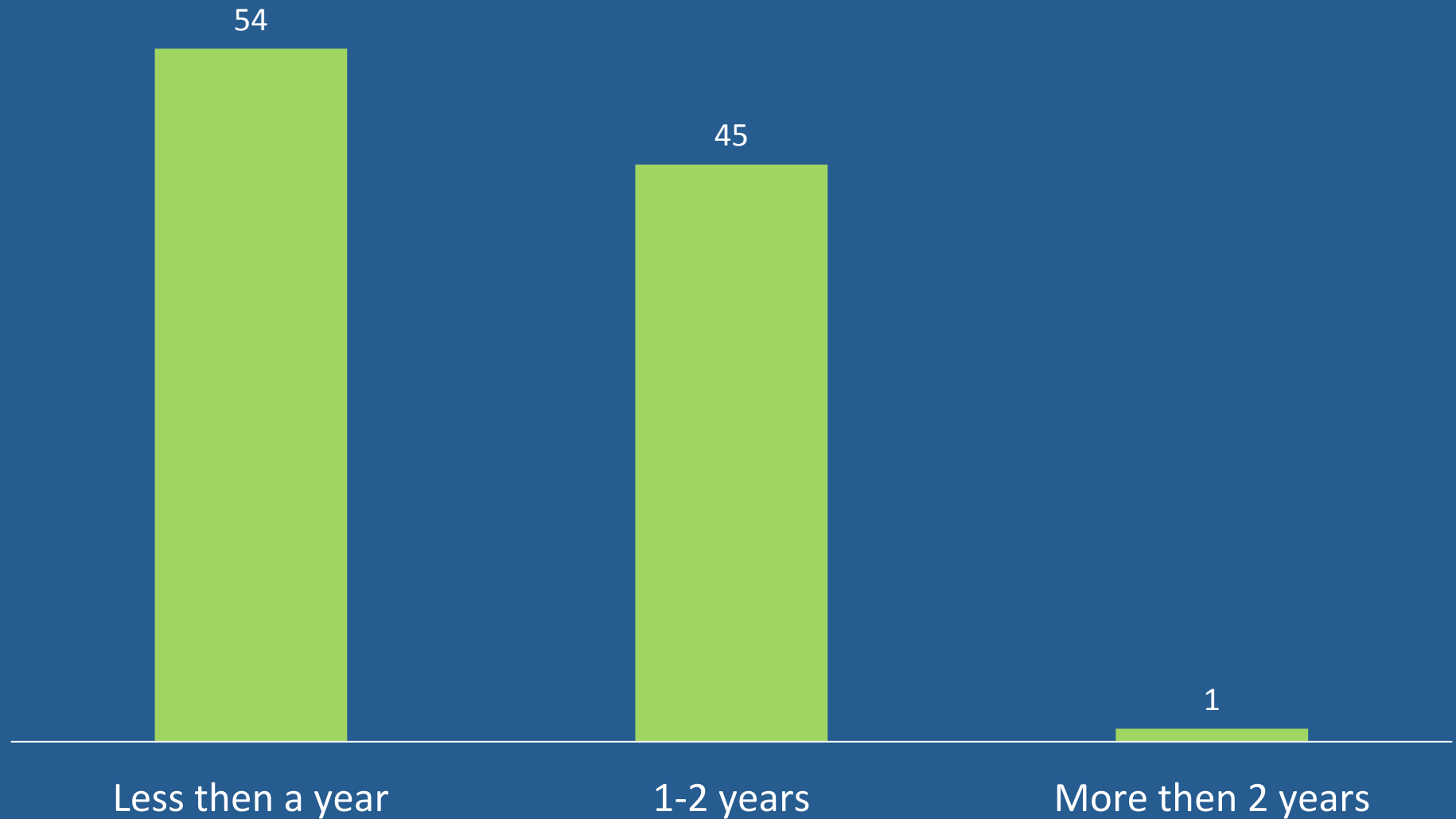

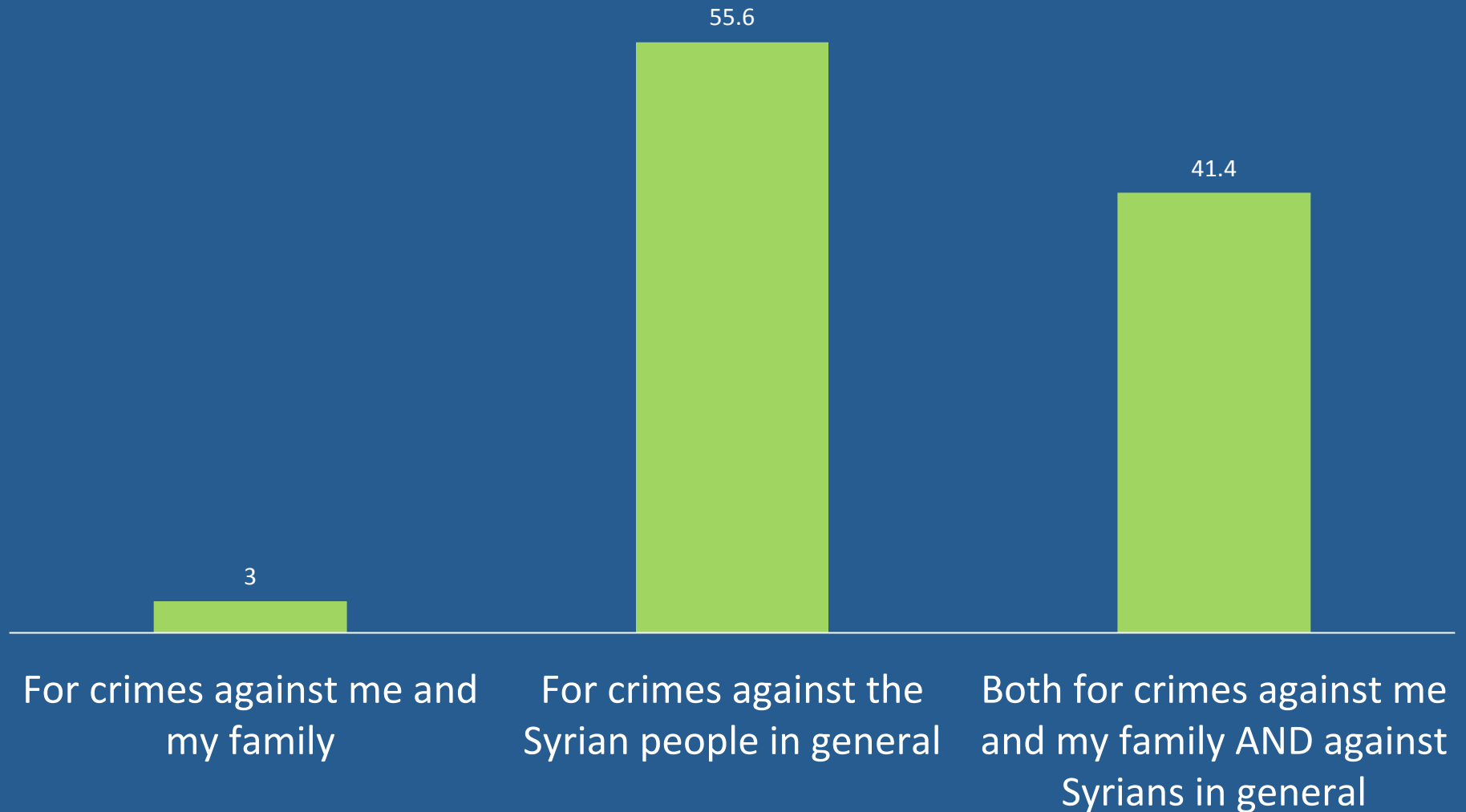

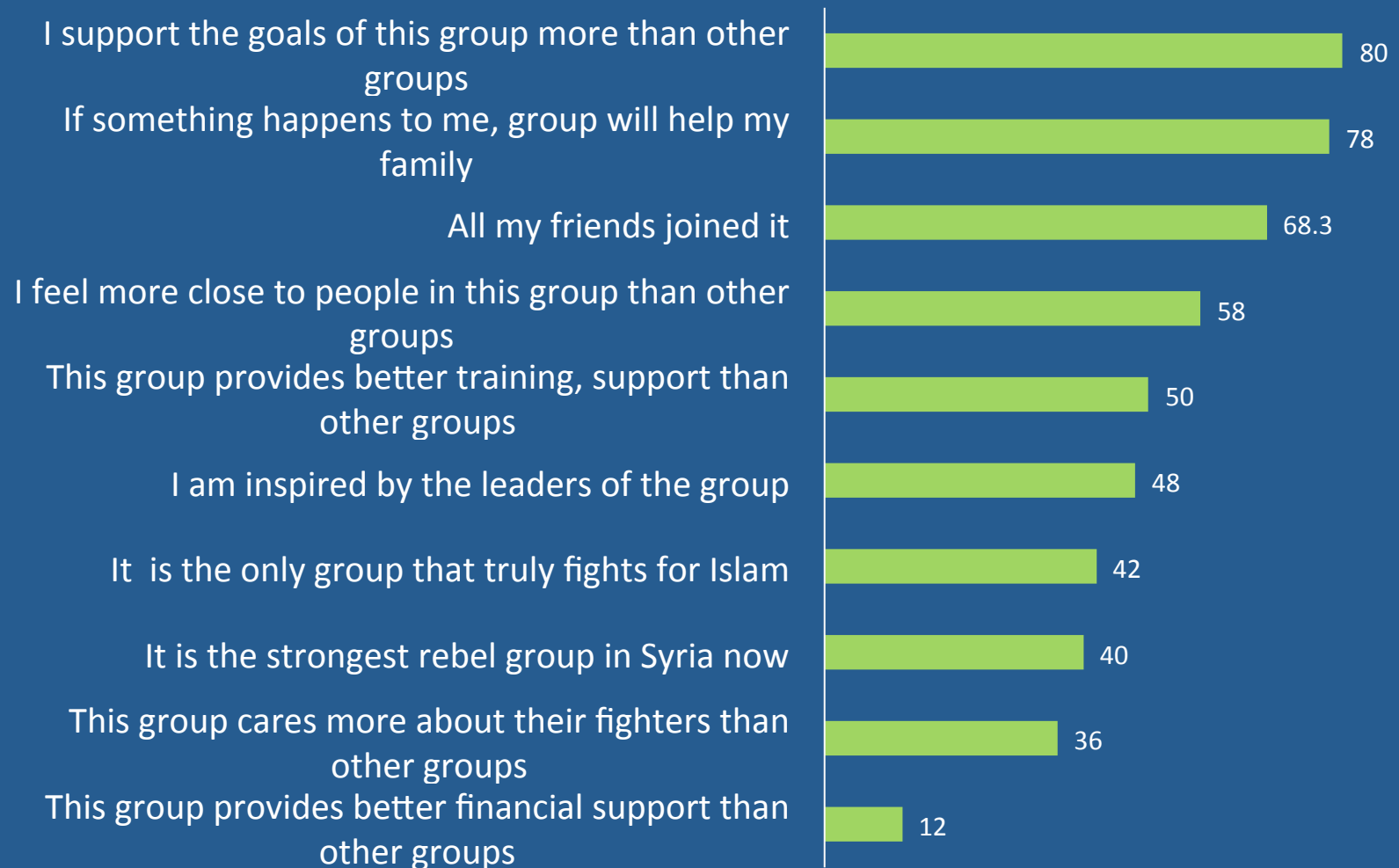

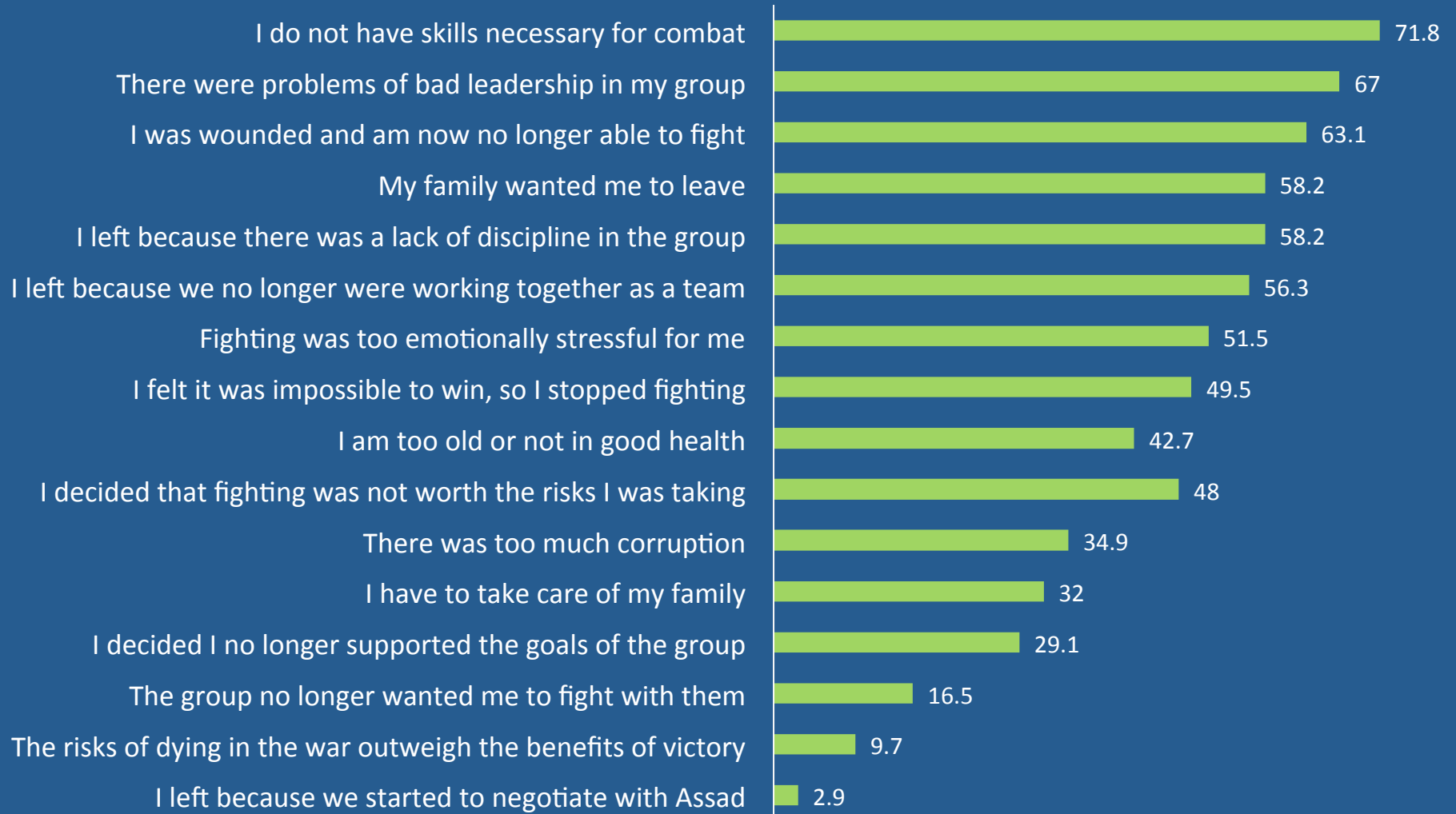

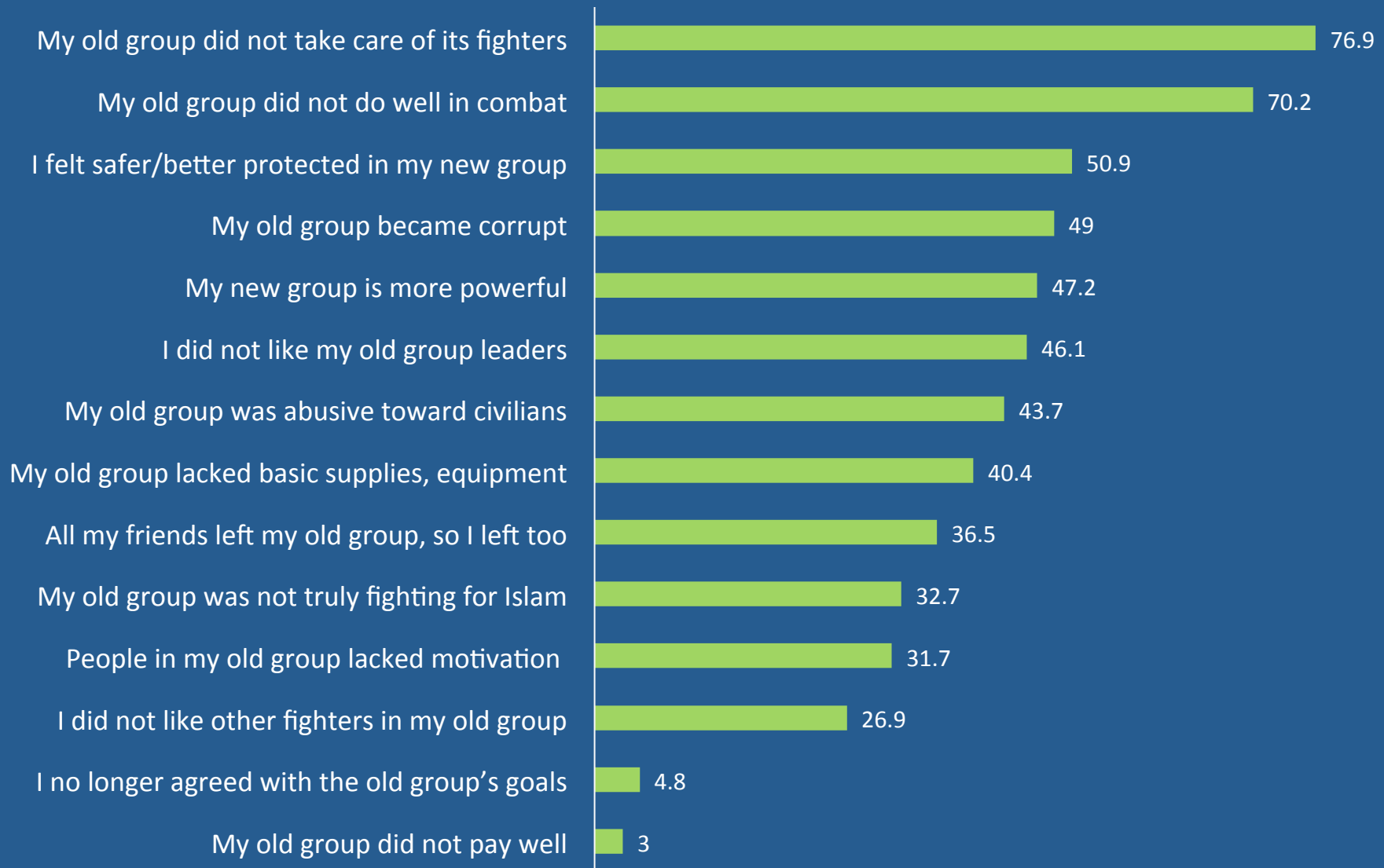

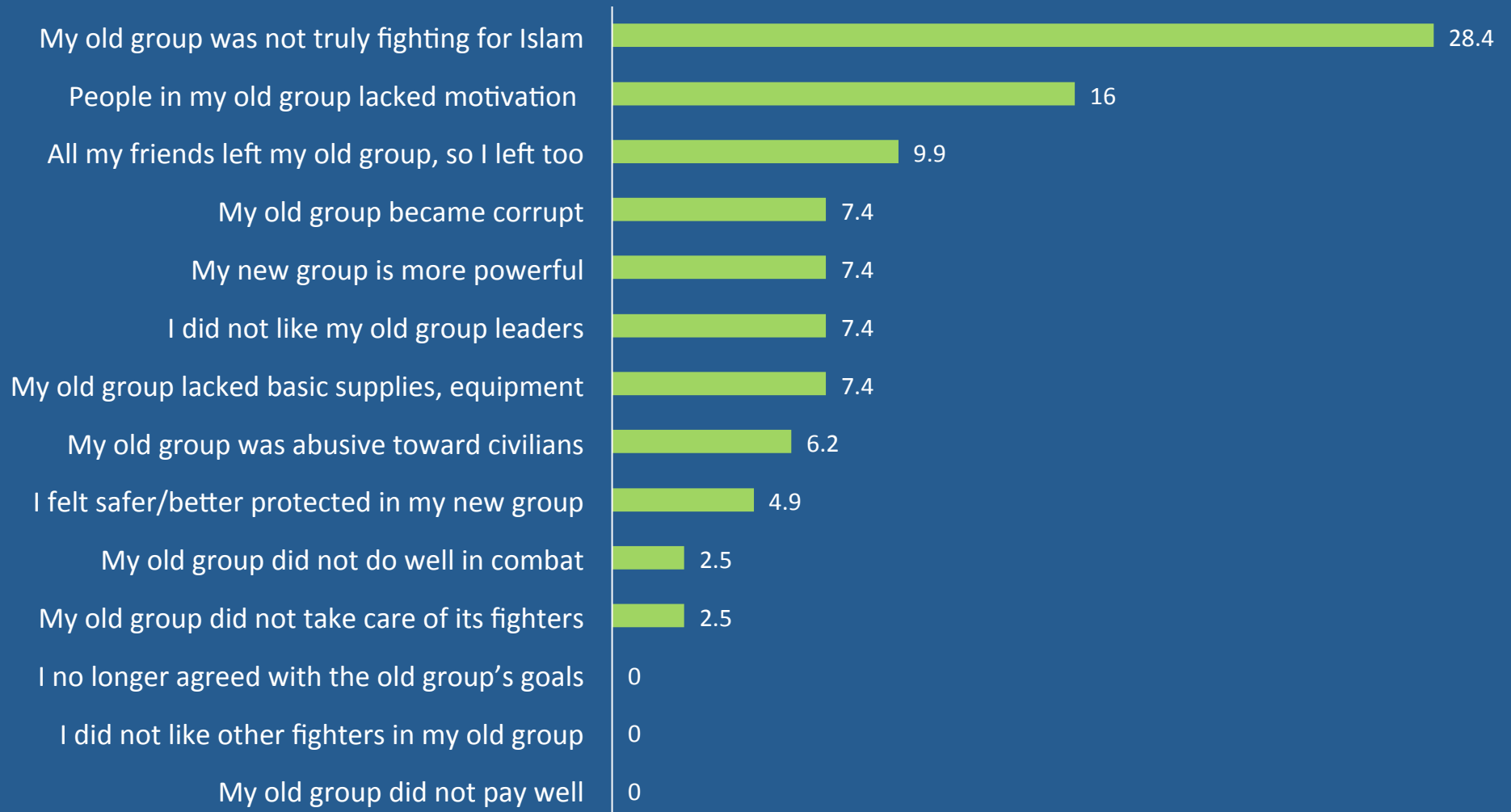

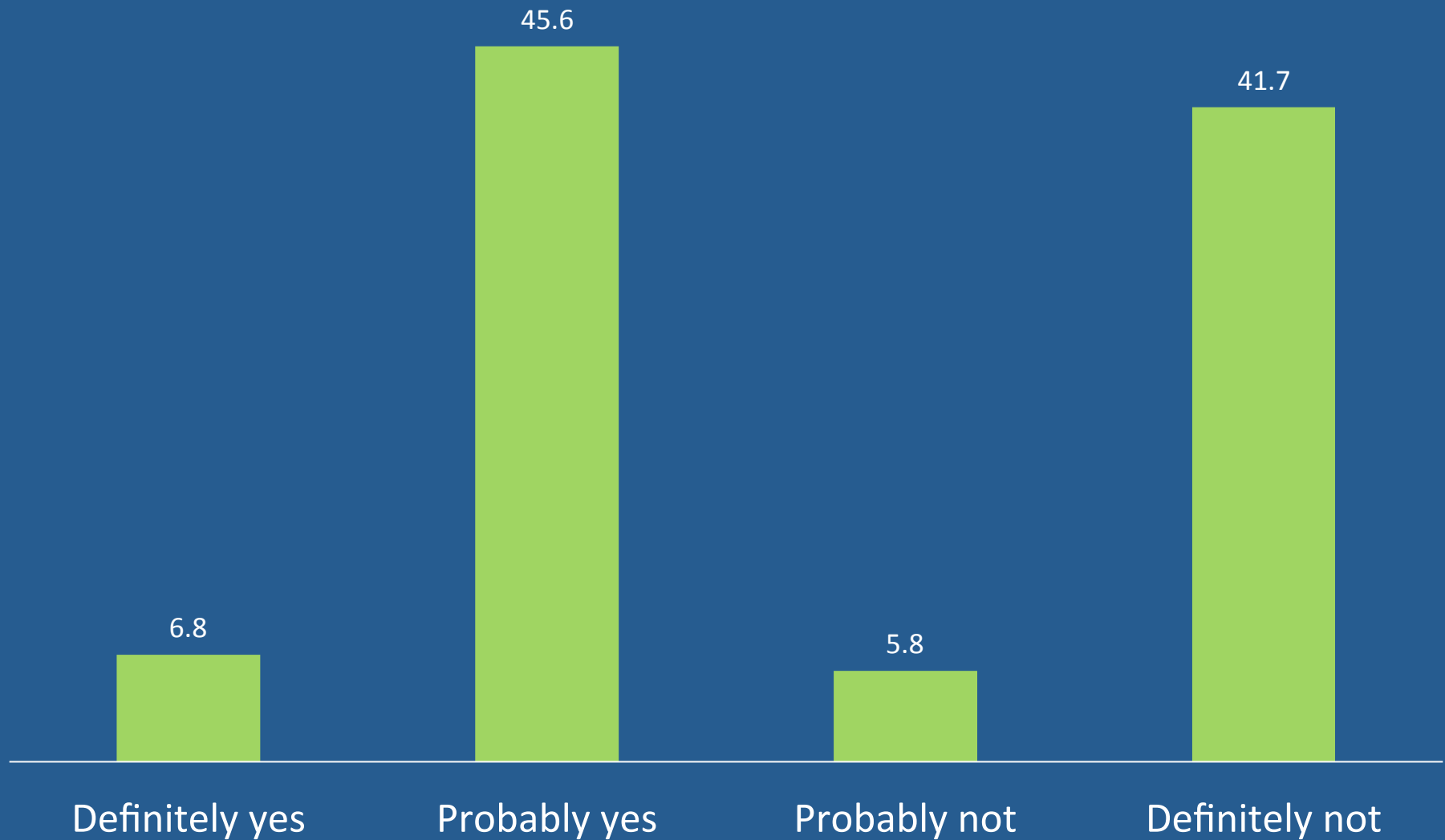

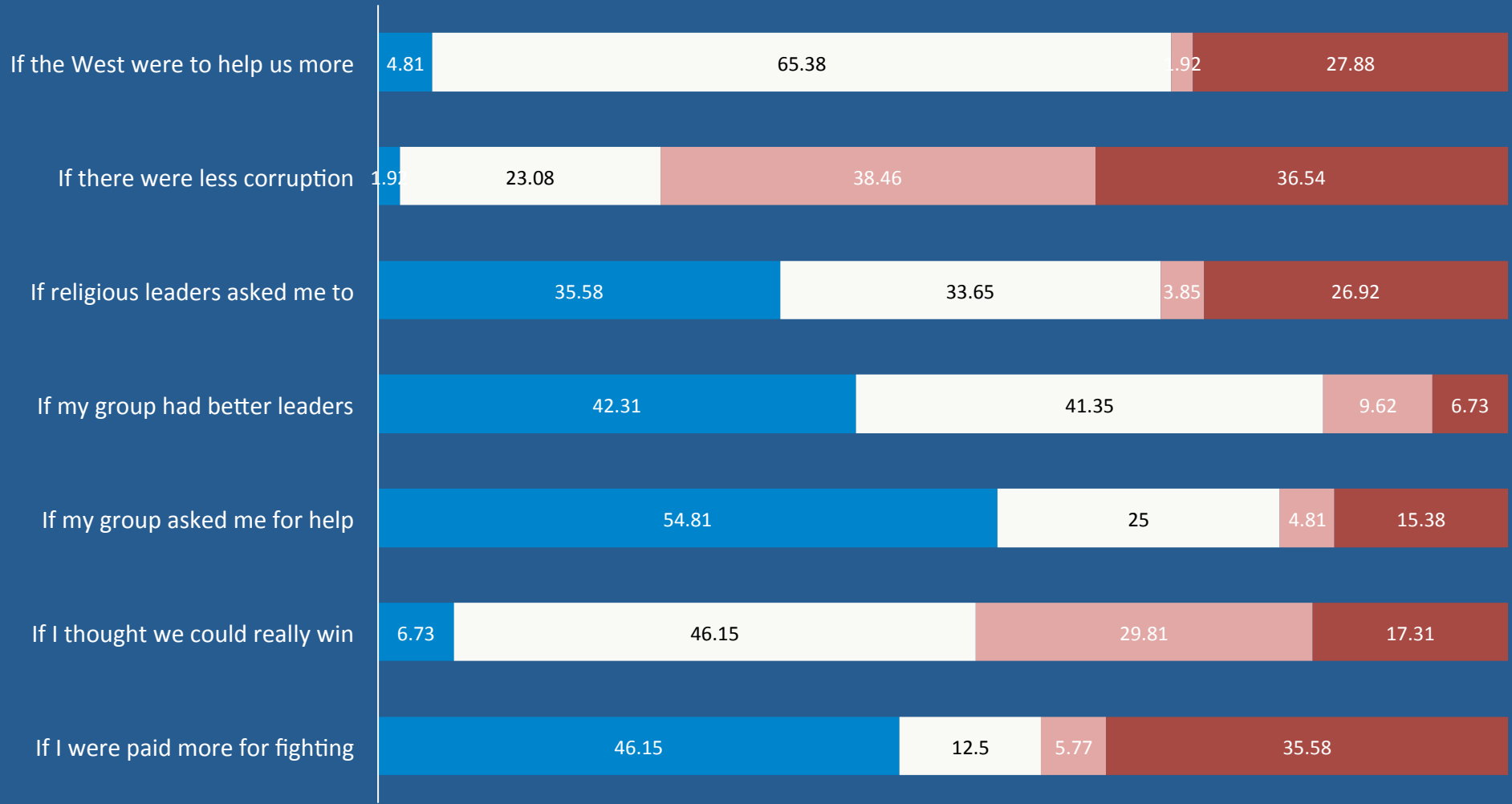

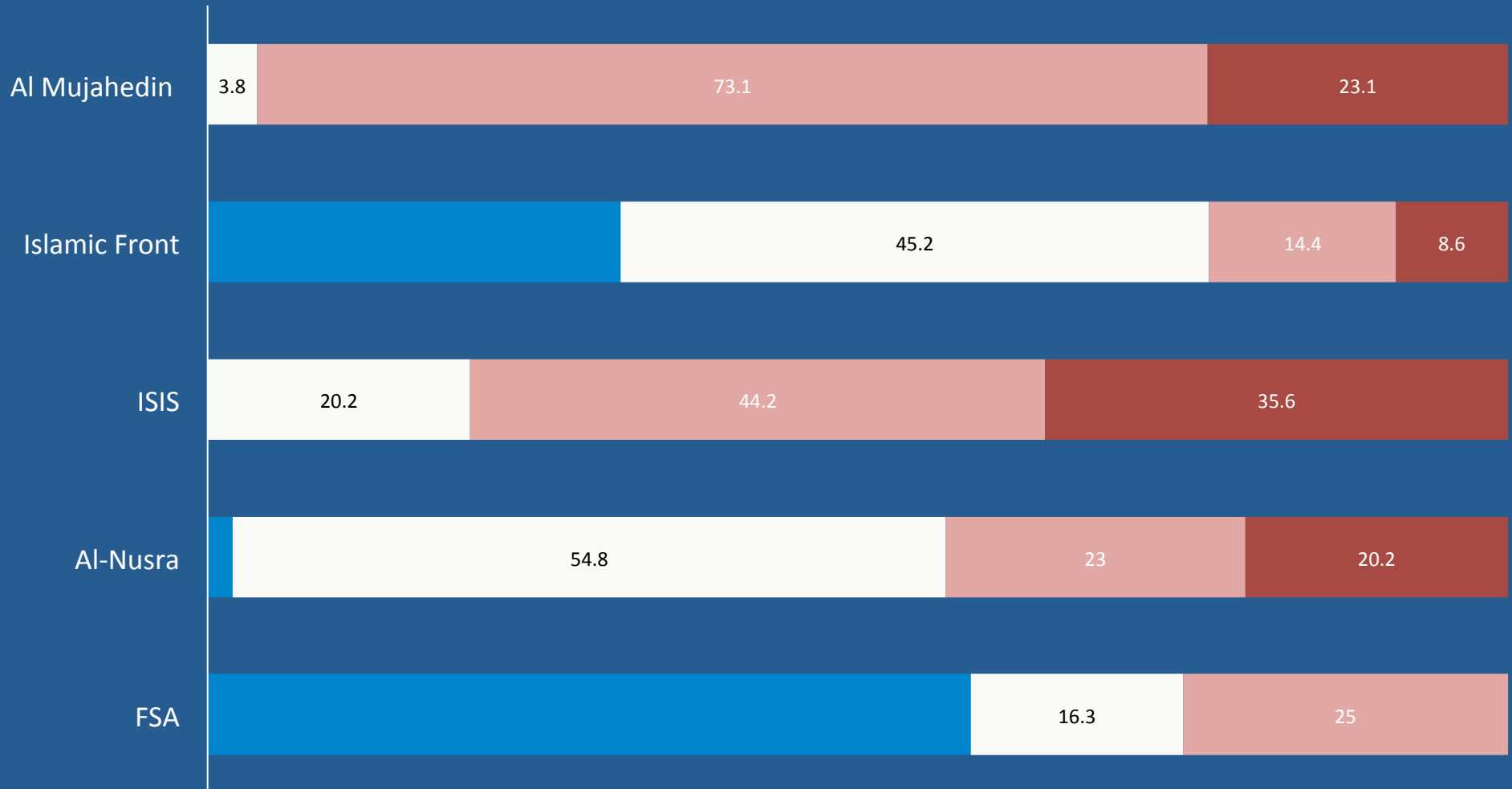

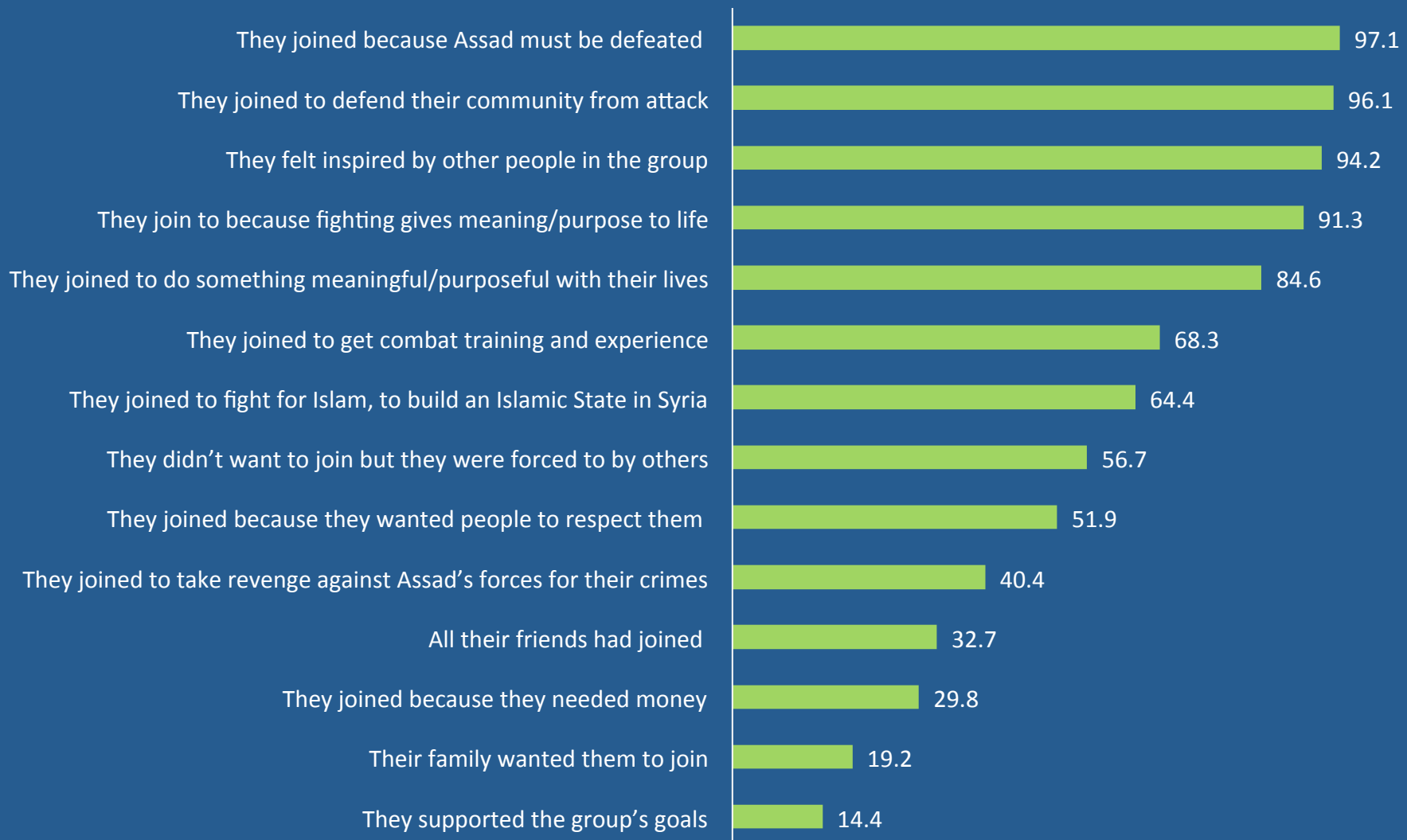

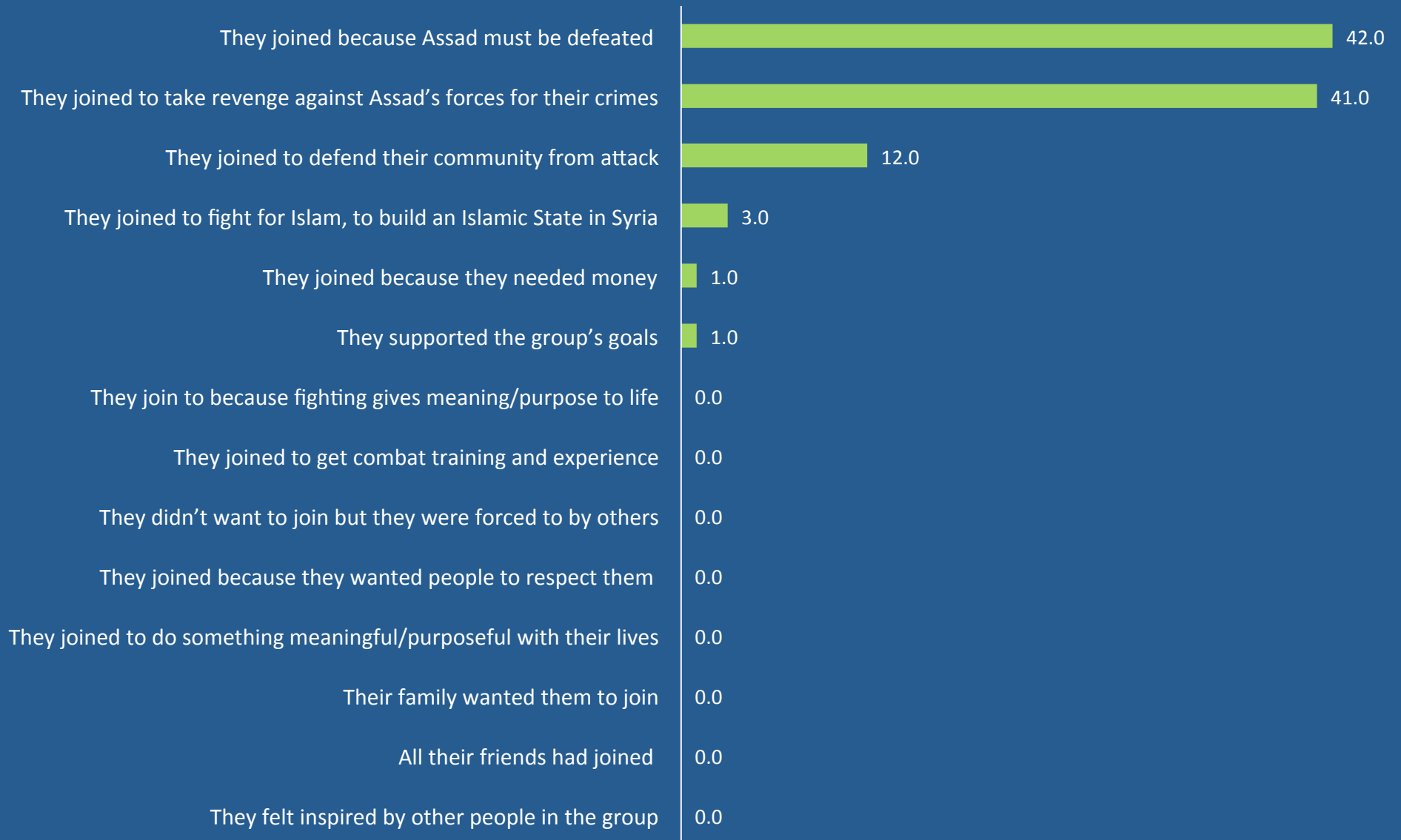

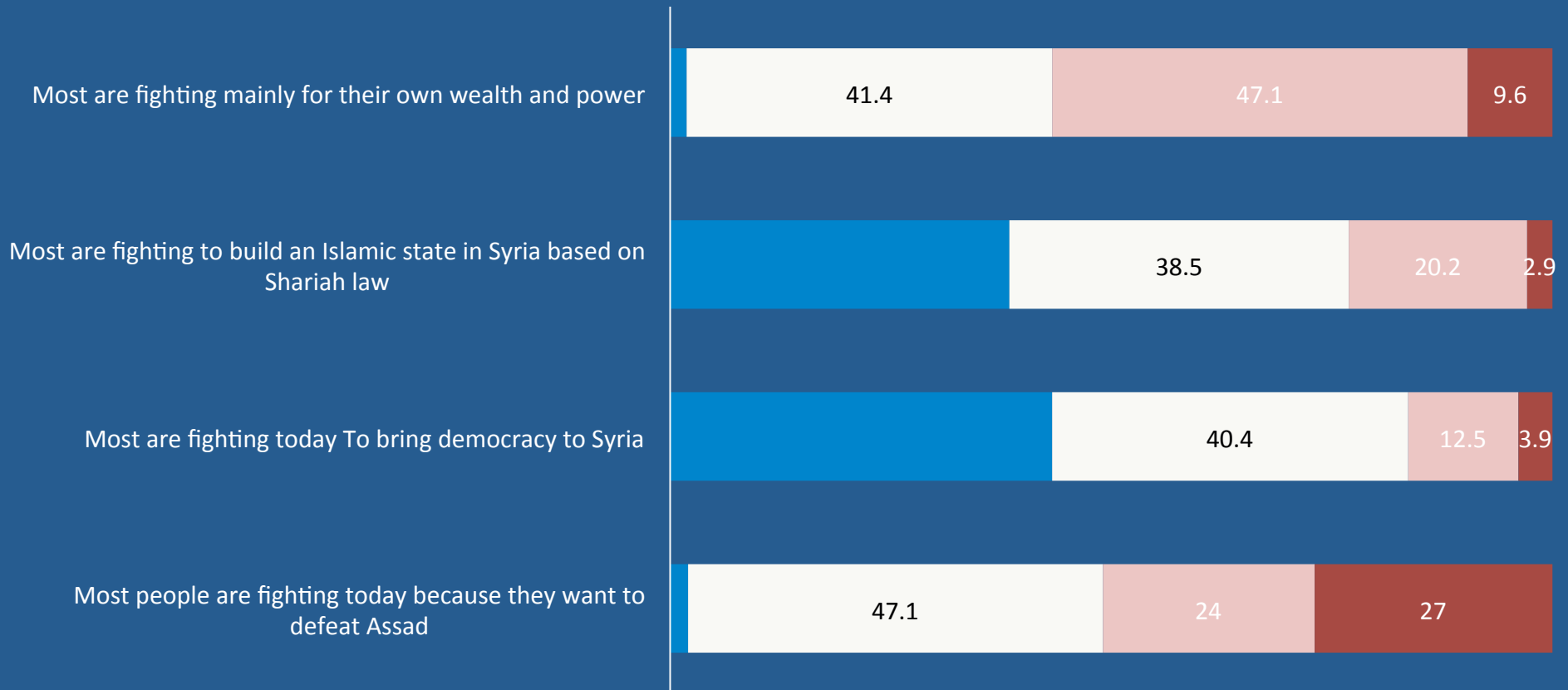
Main Reason Given For Why Others Joined Your Group Q: *And what was the most important reason ? (%)*

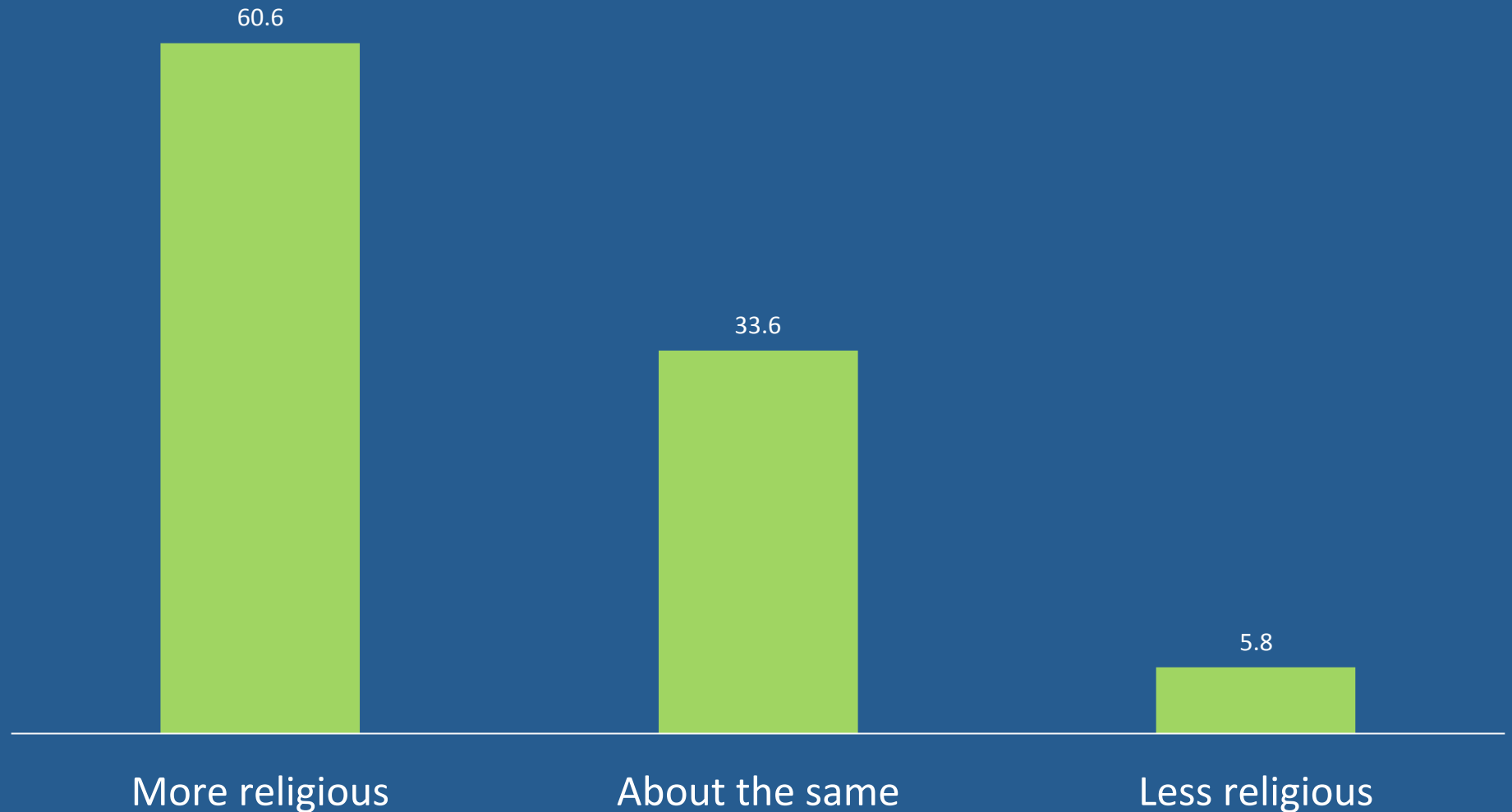

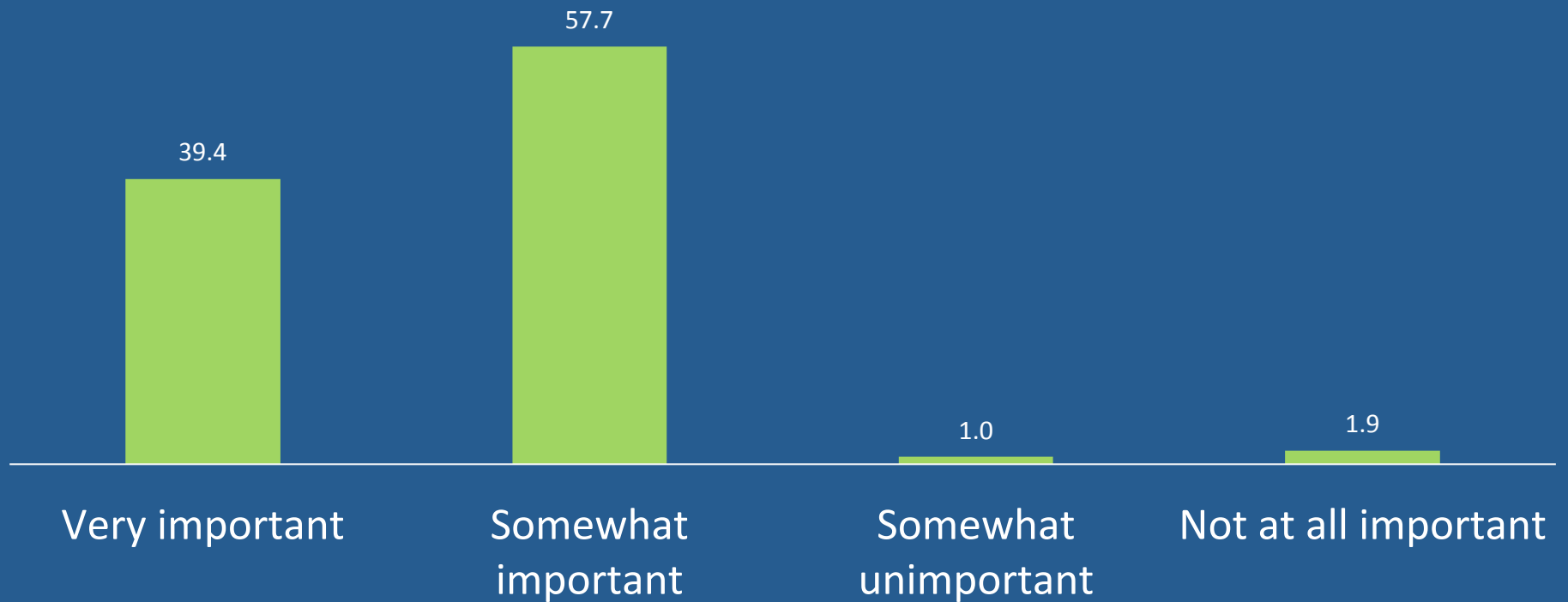

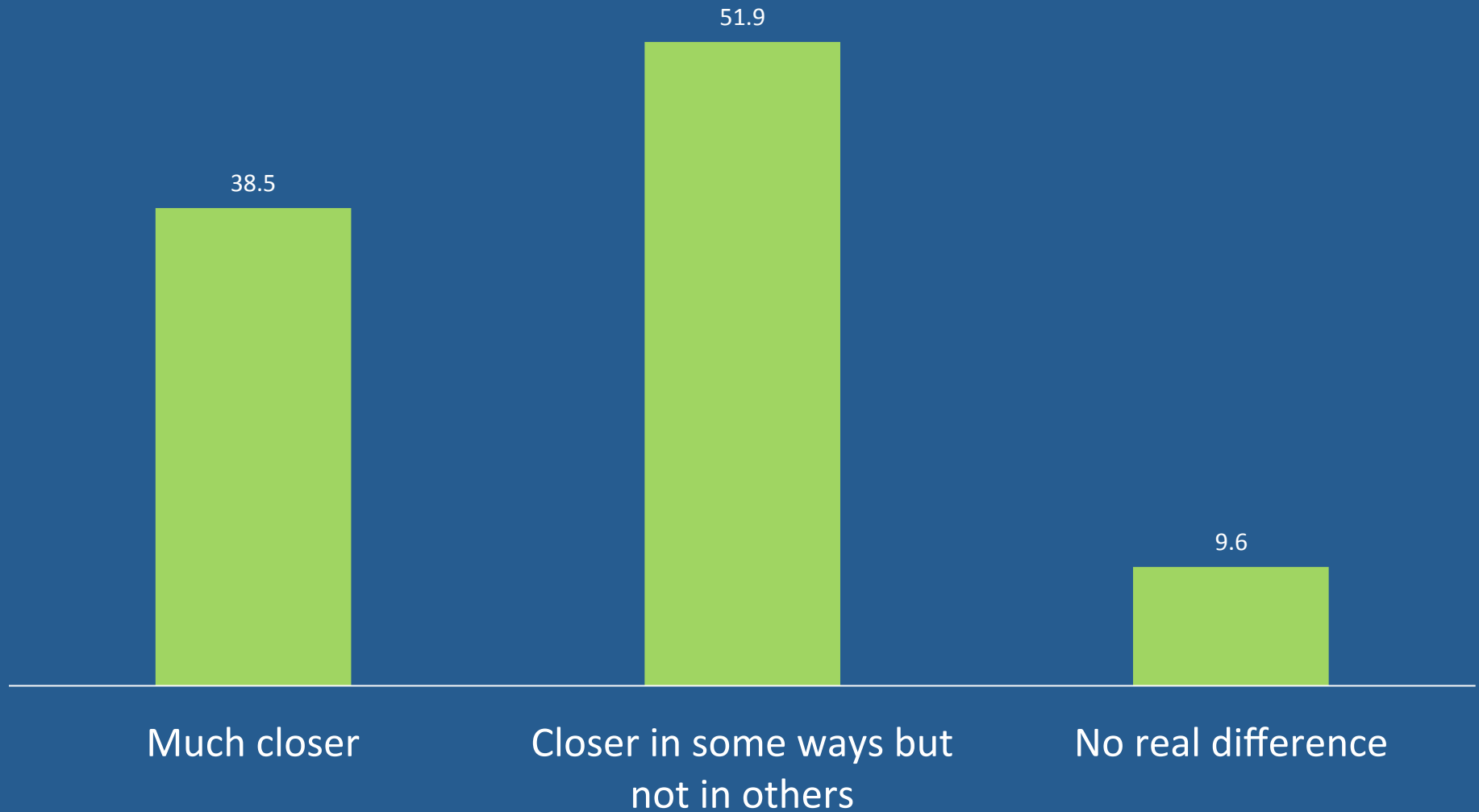

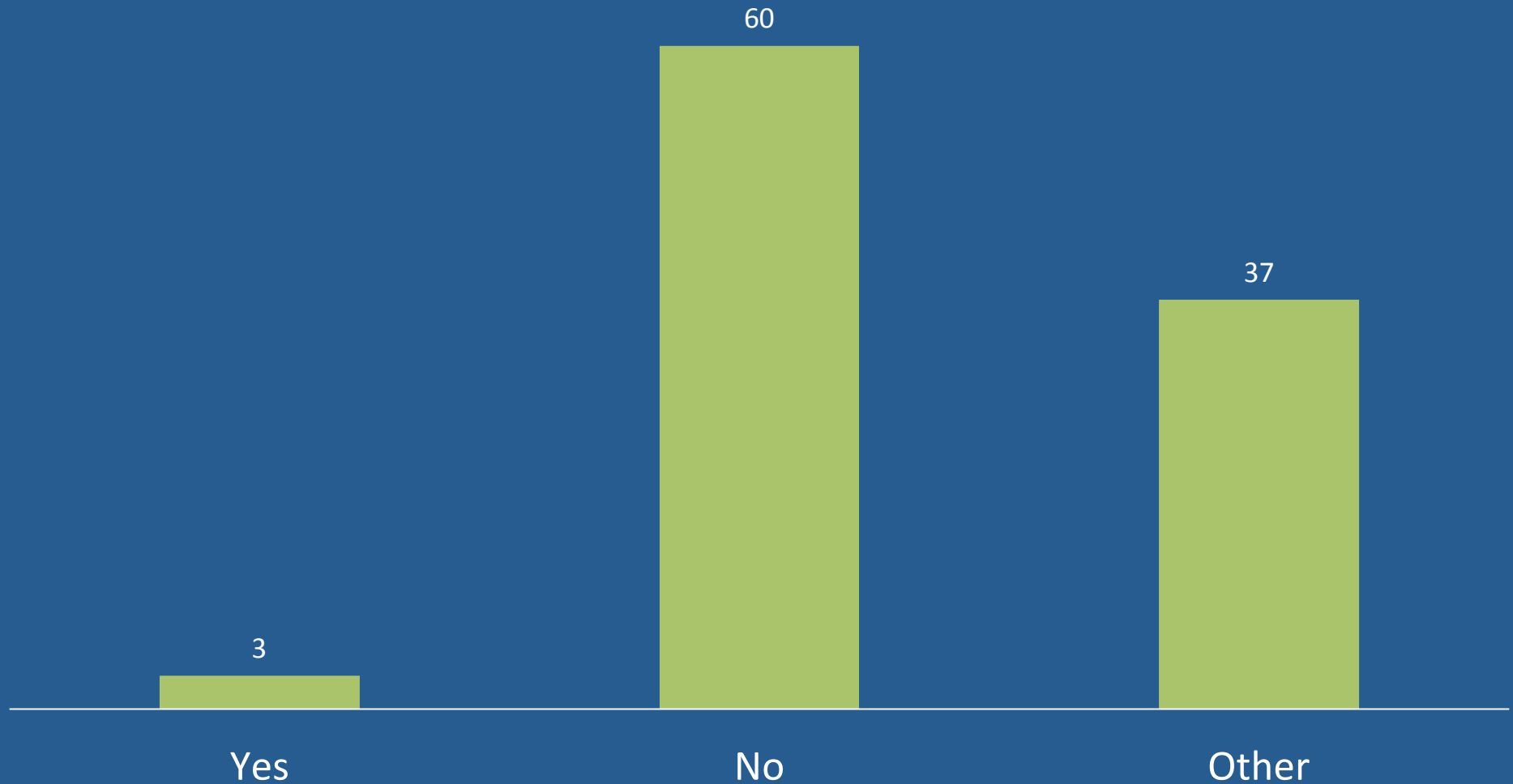

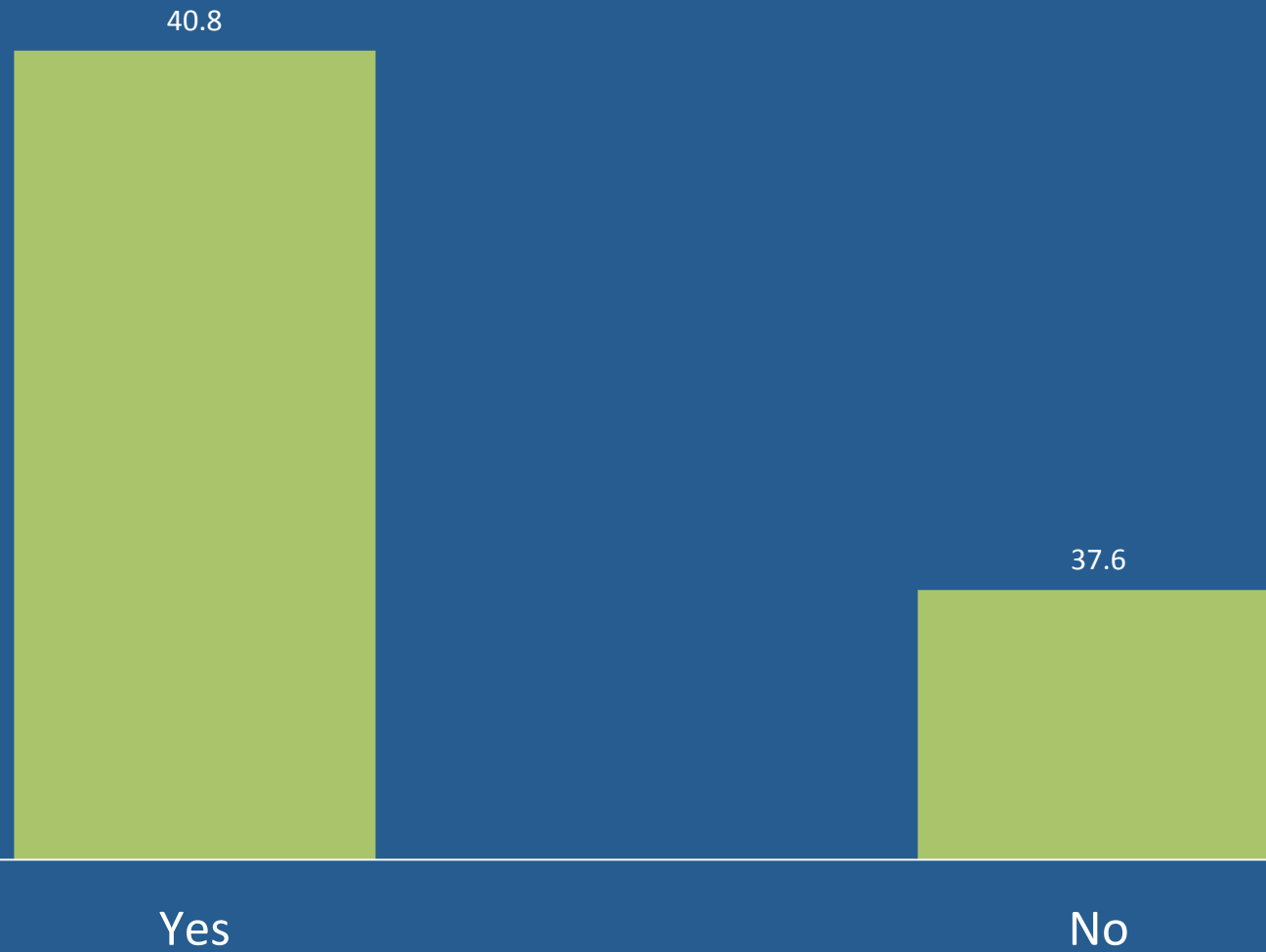

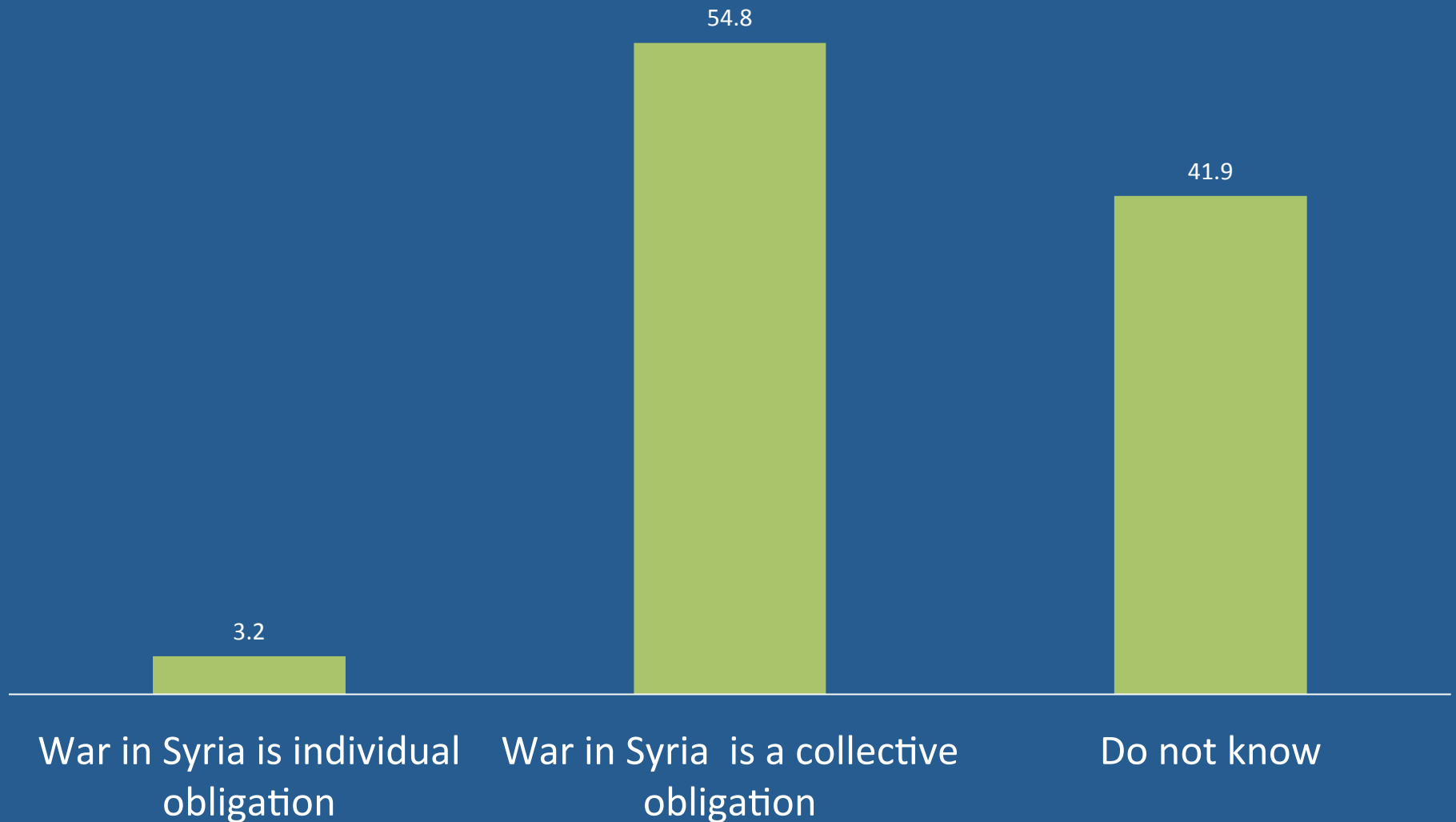

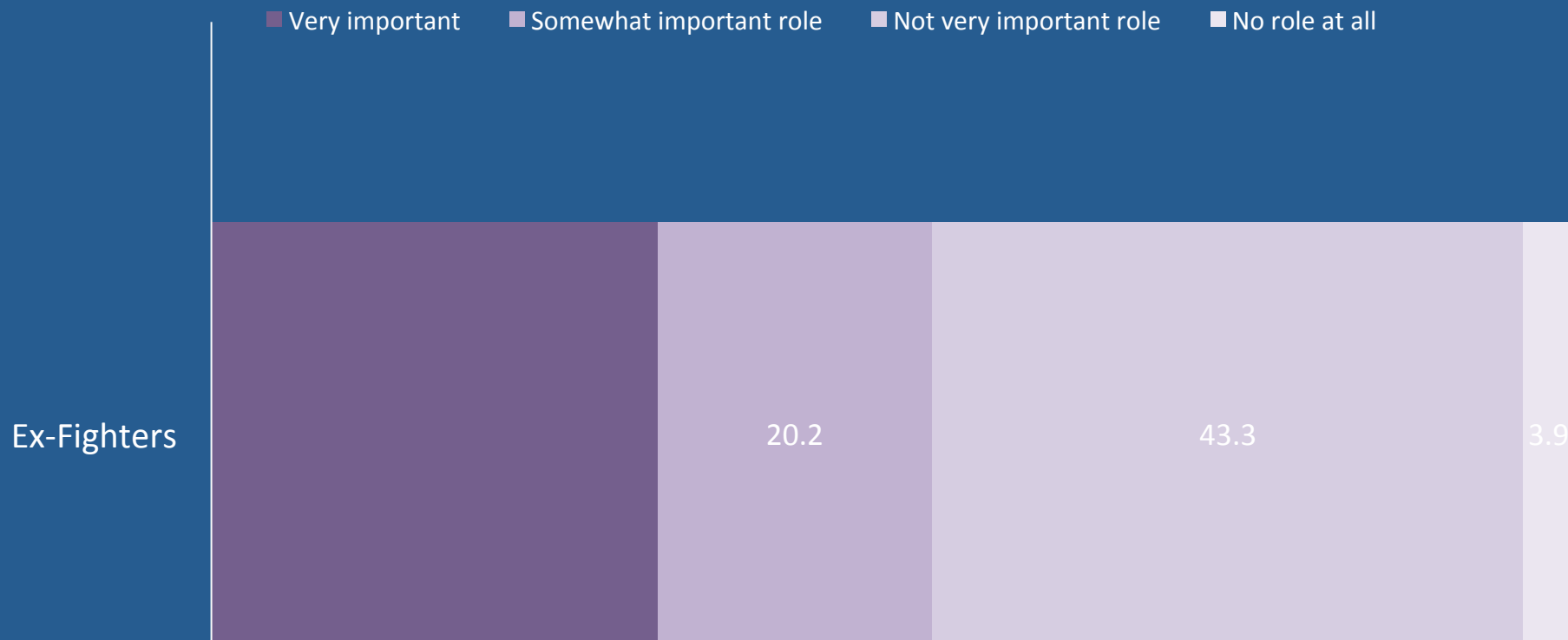

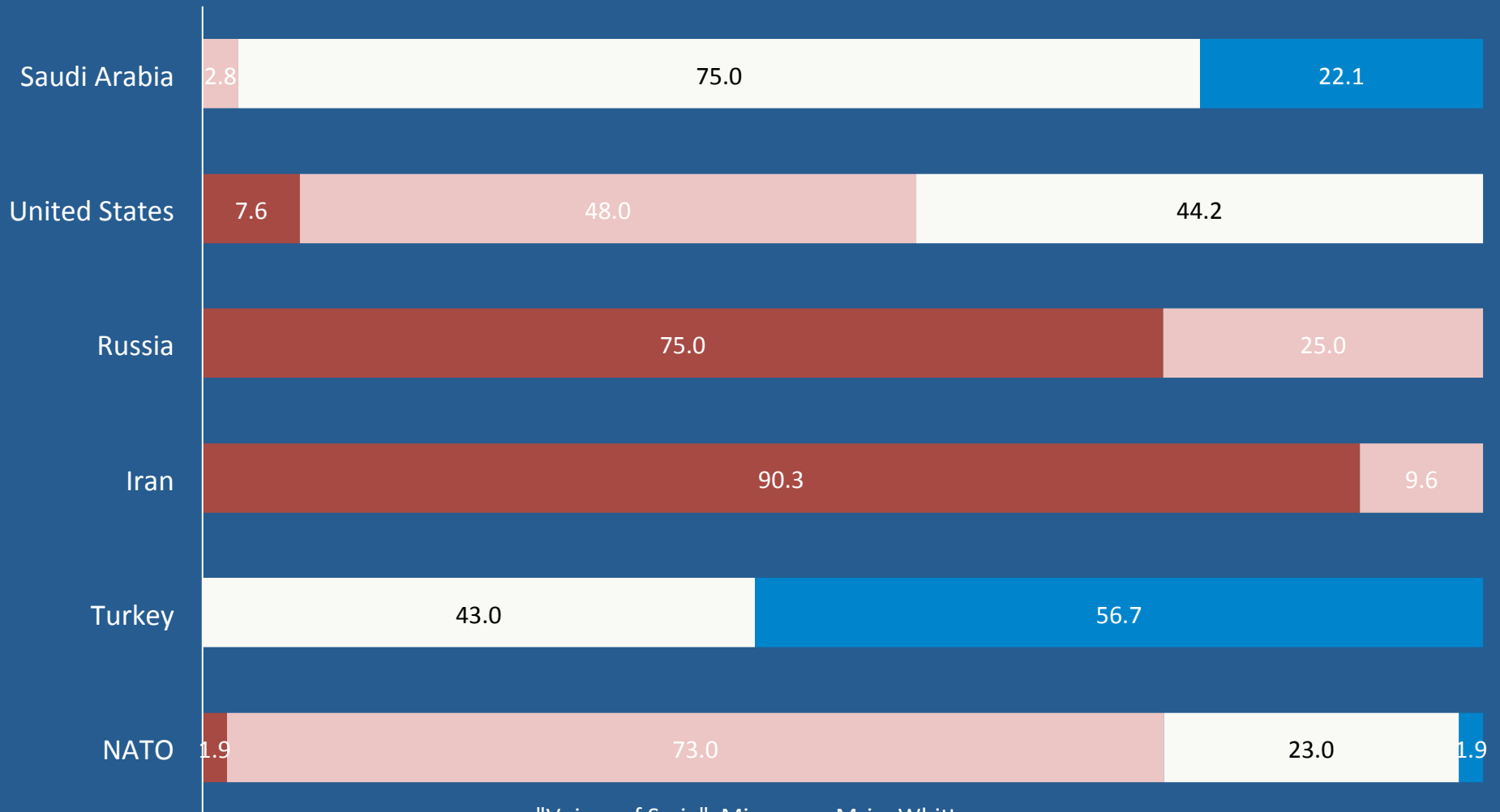

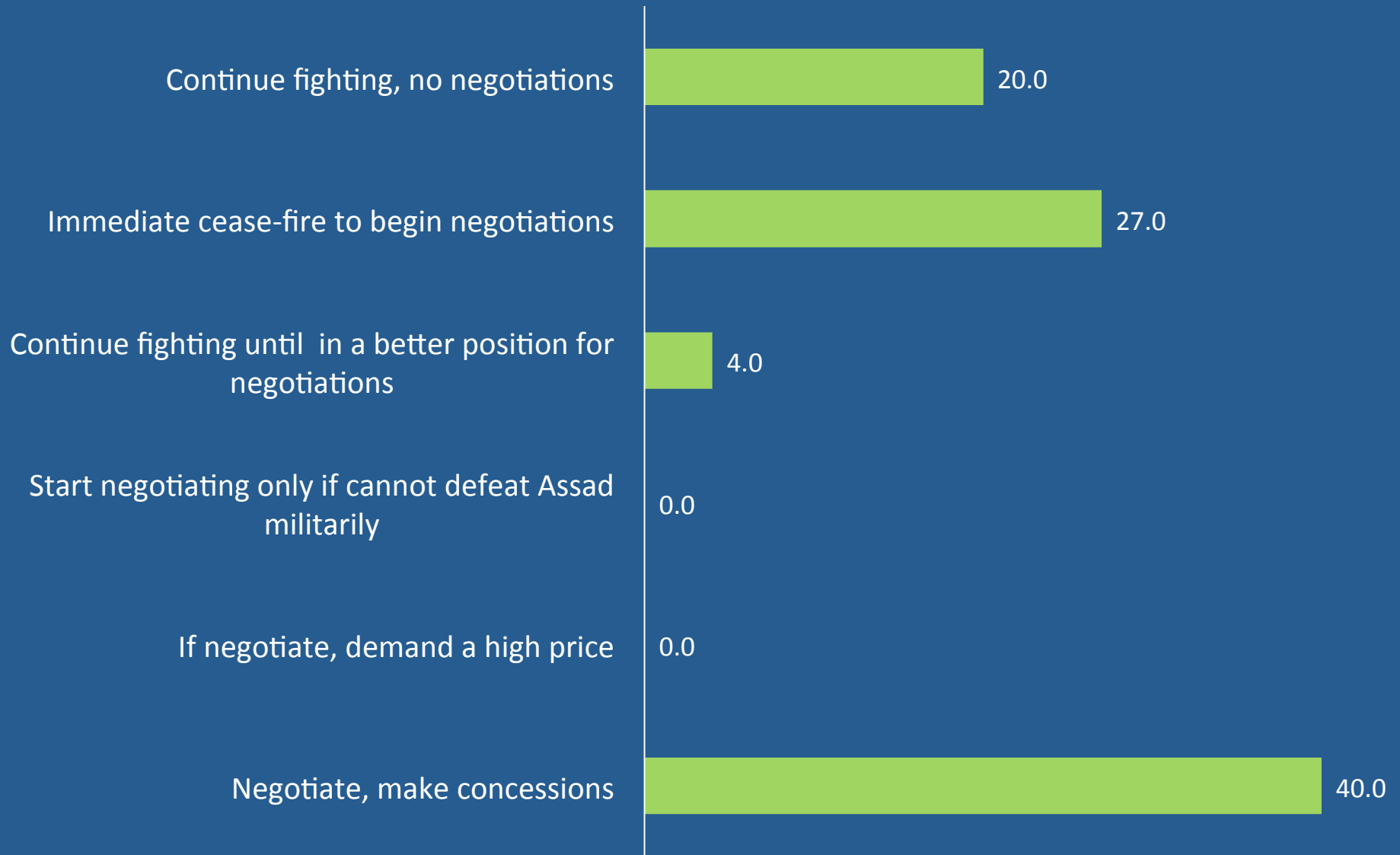

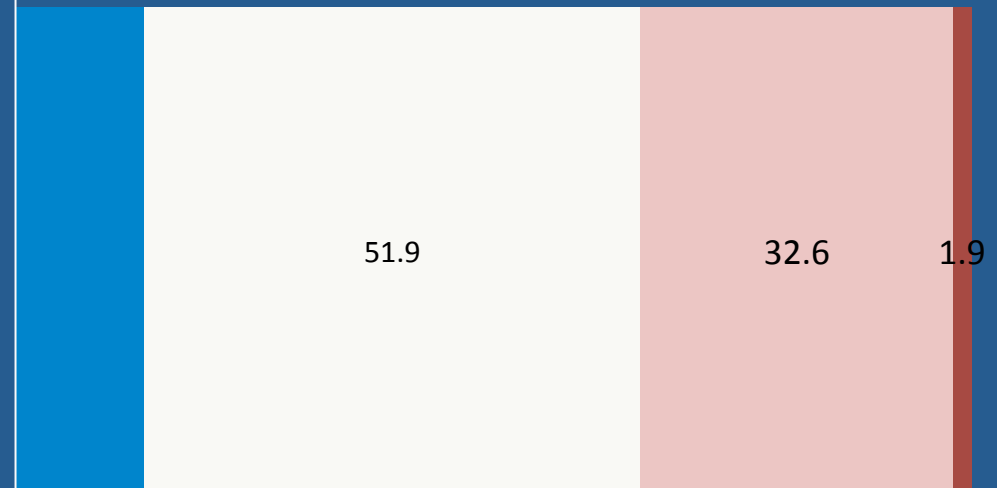

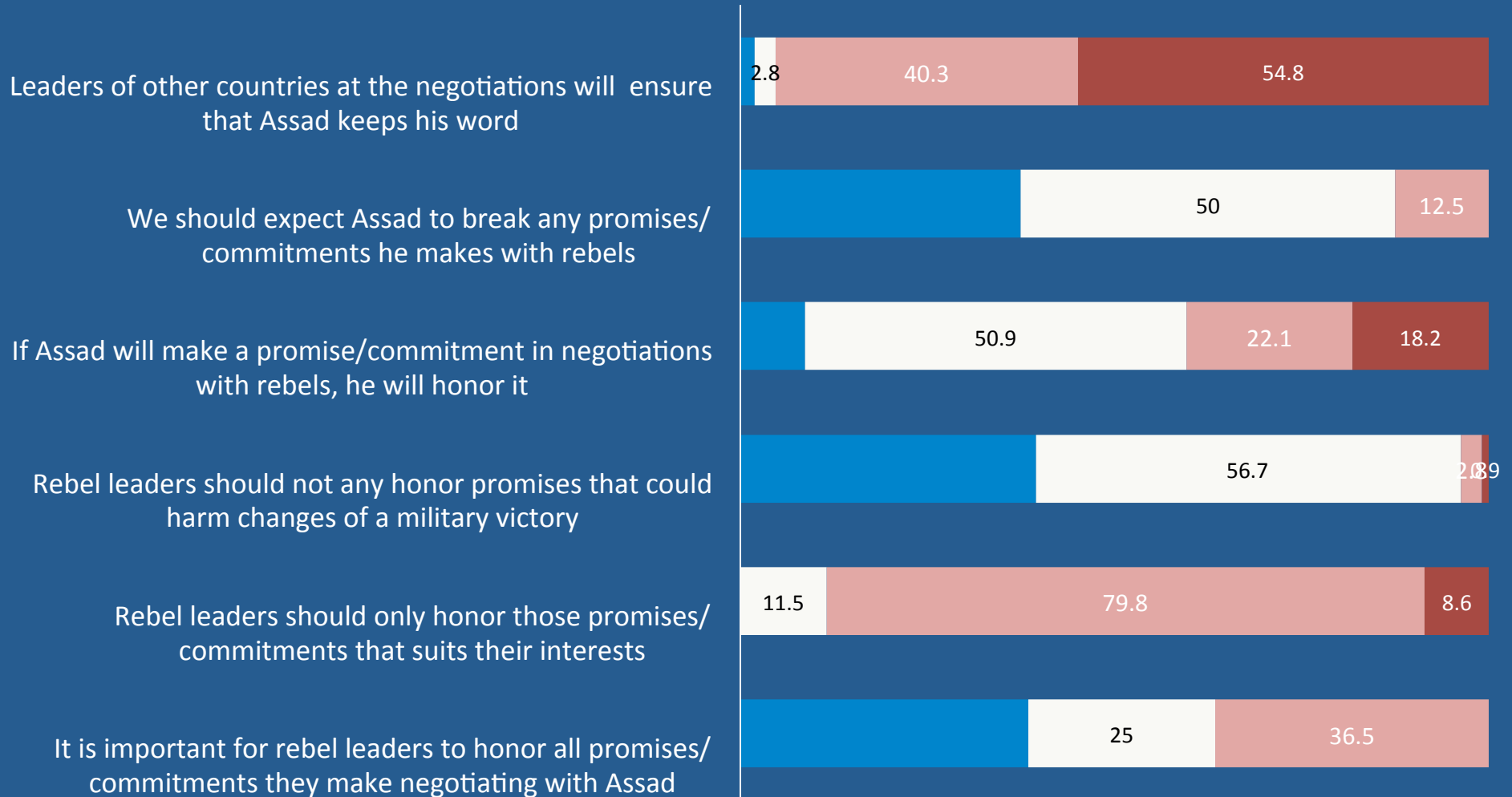

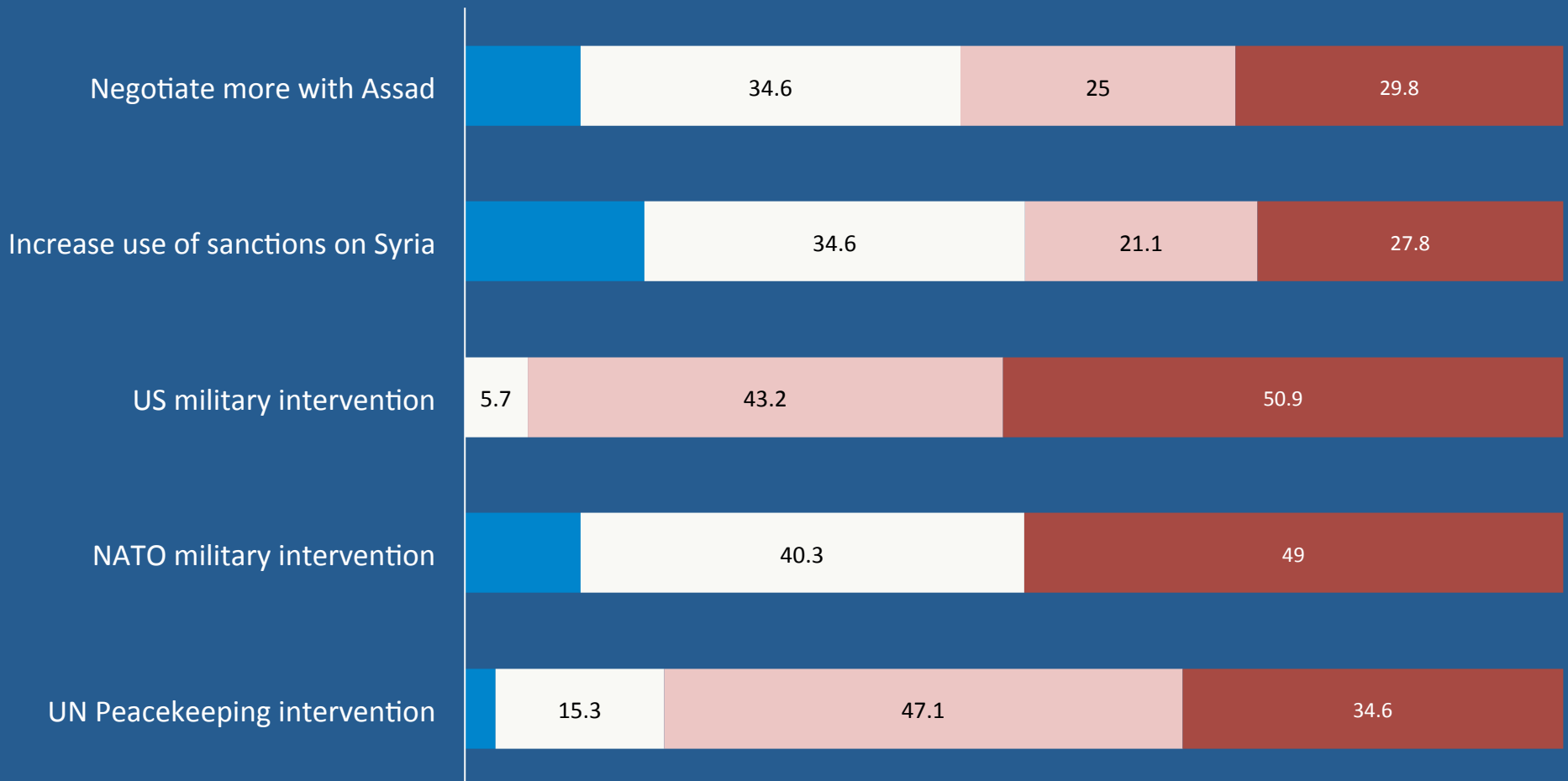

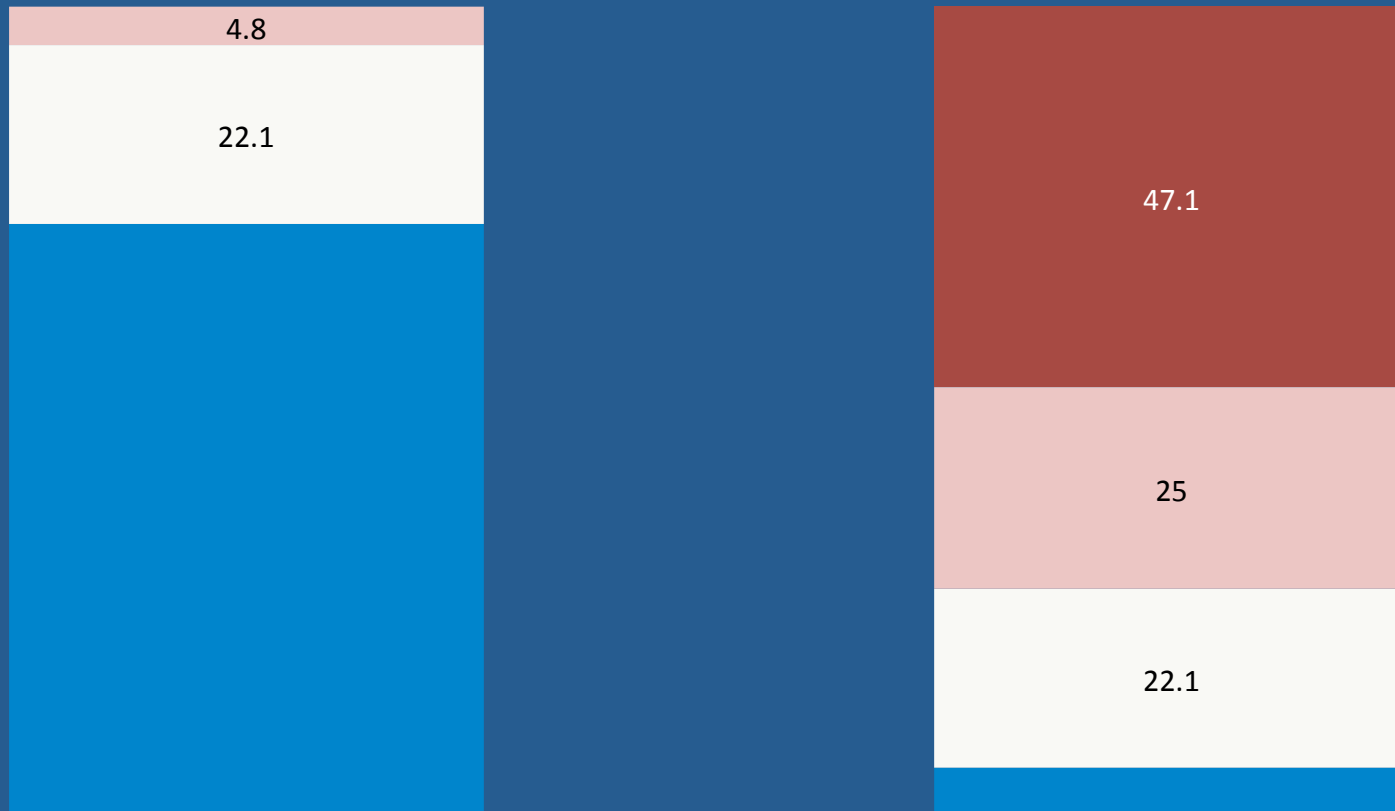

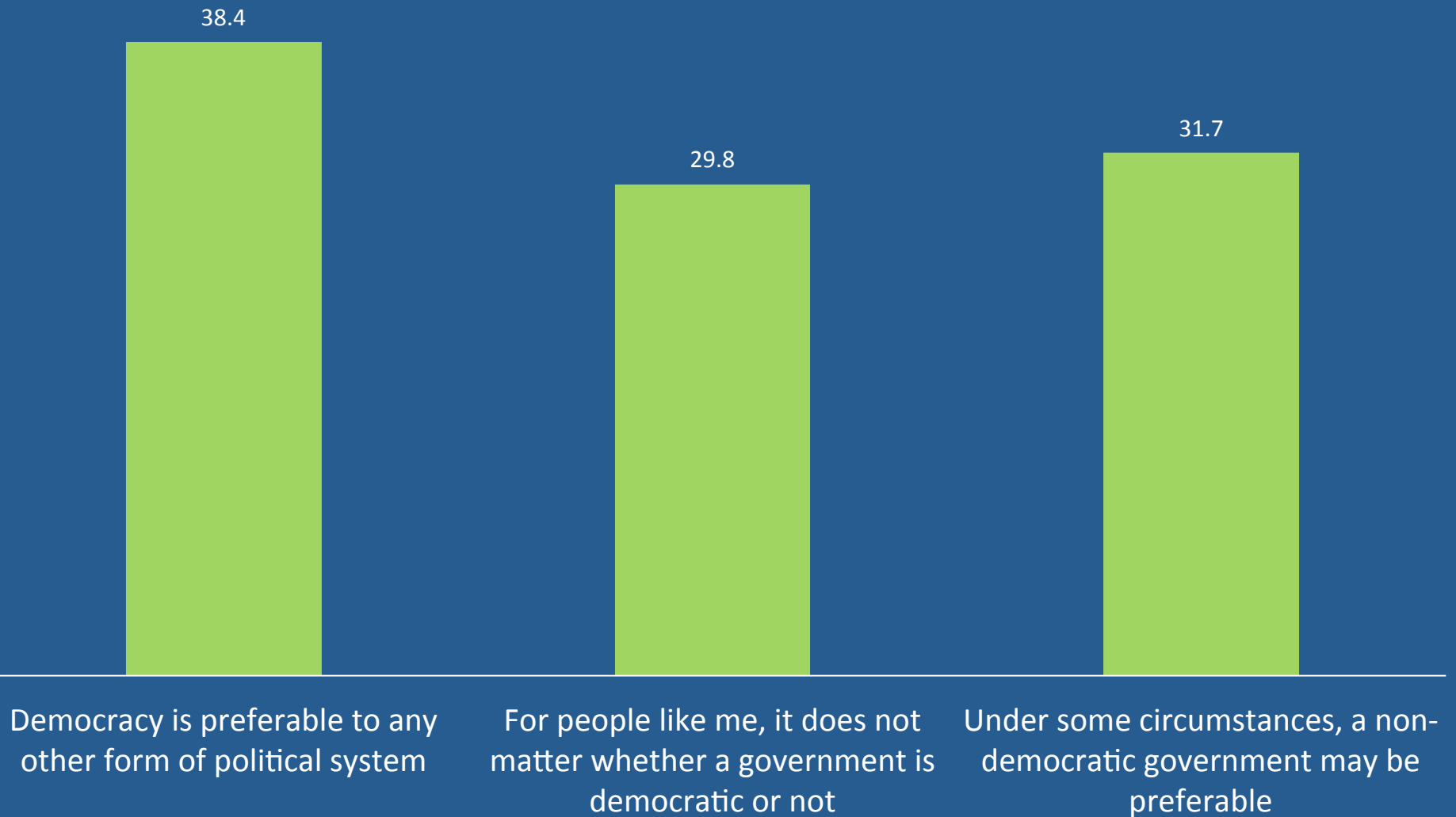

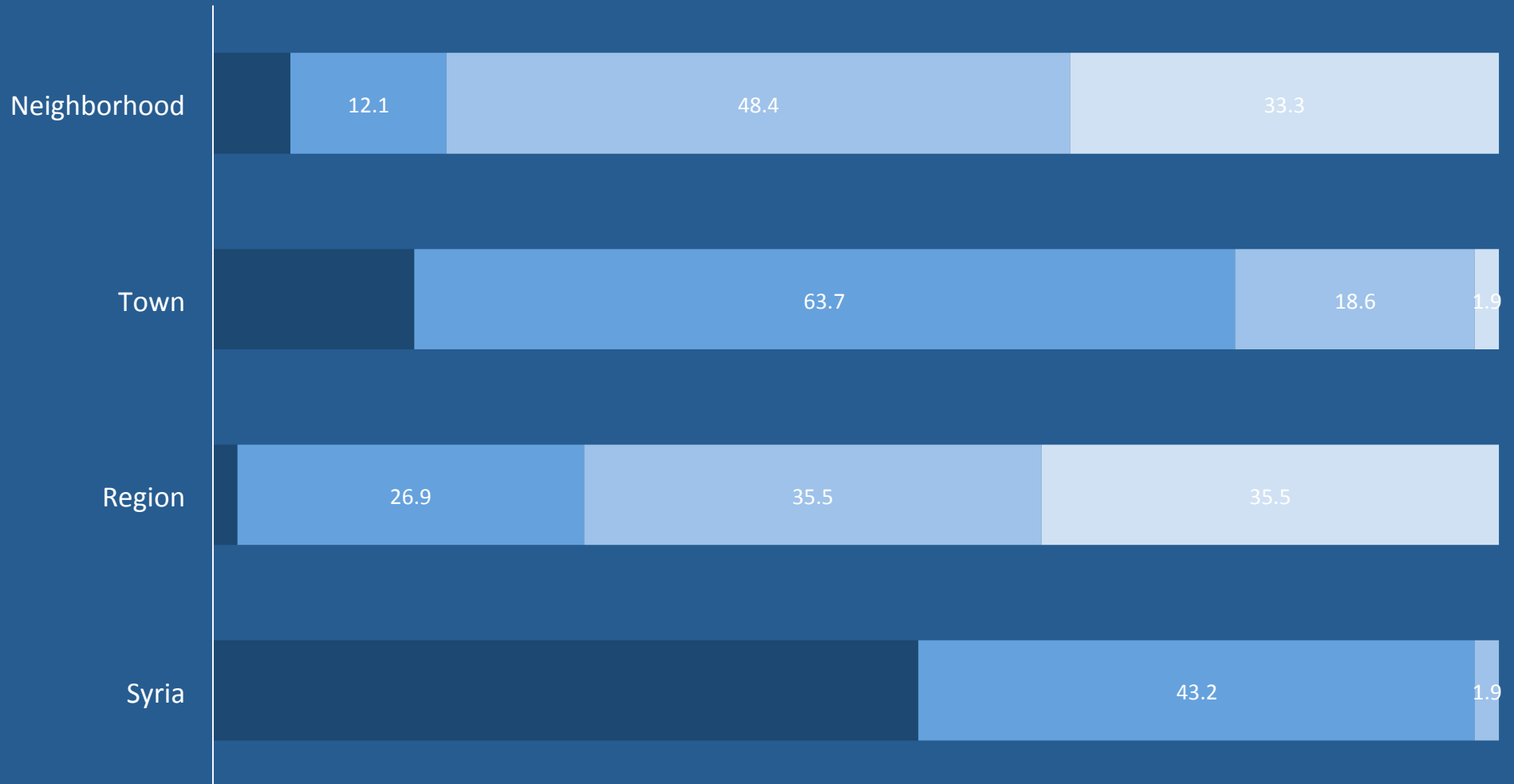

Social Distance by Location

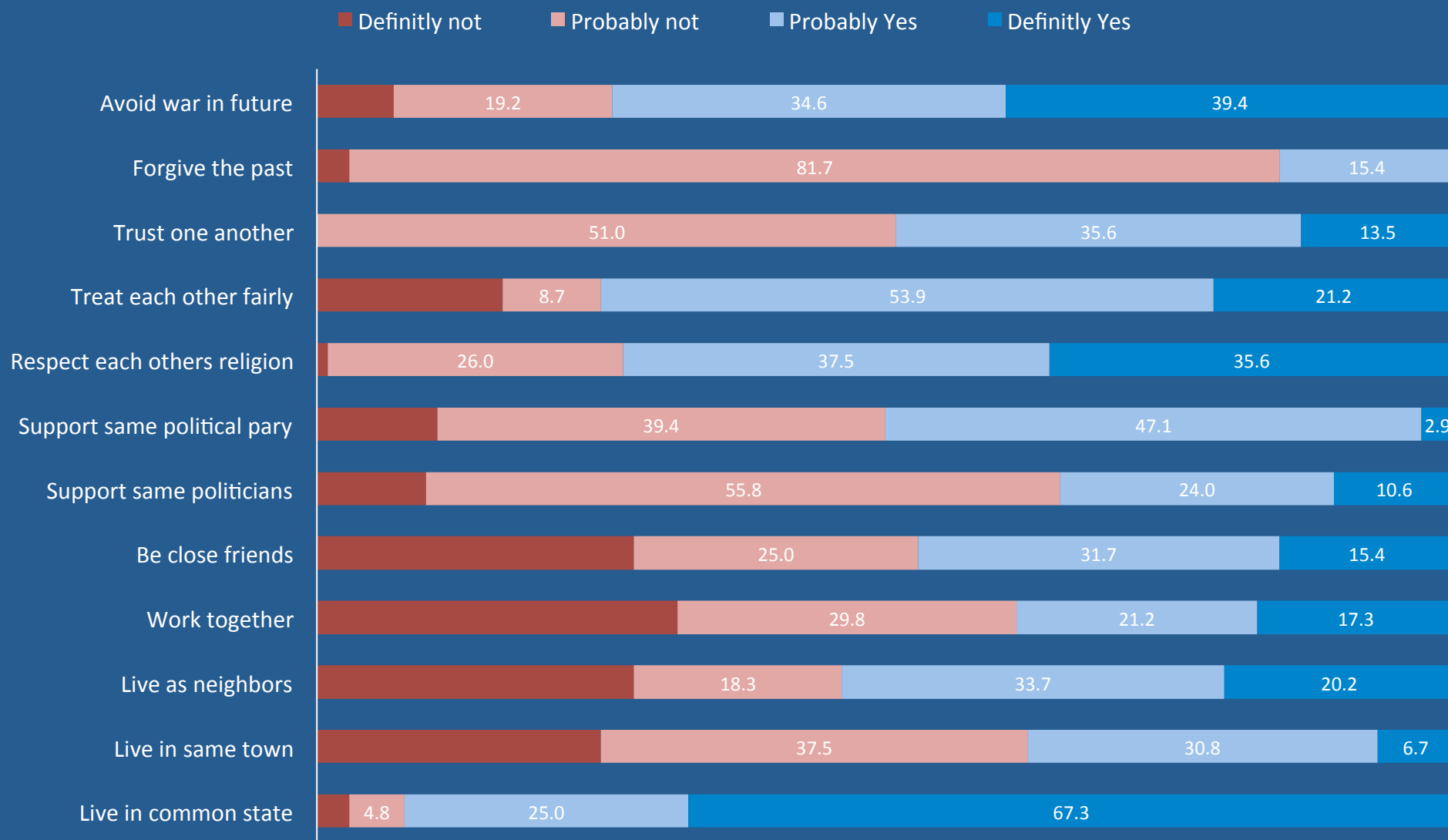

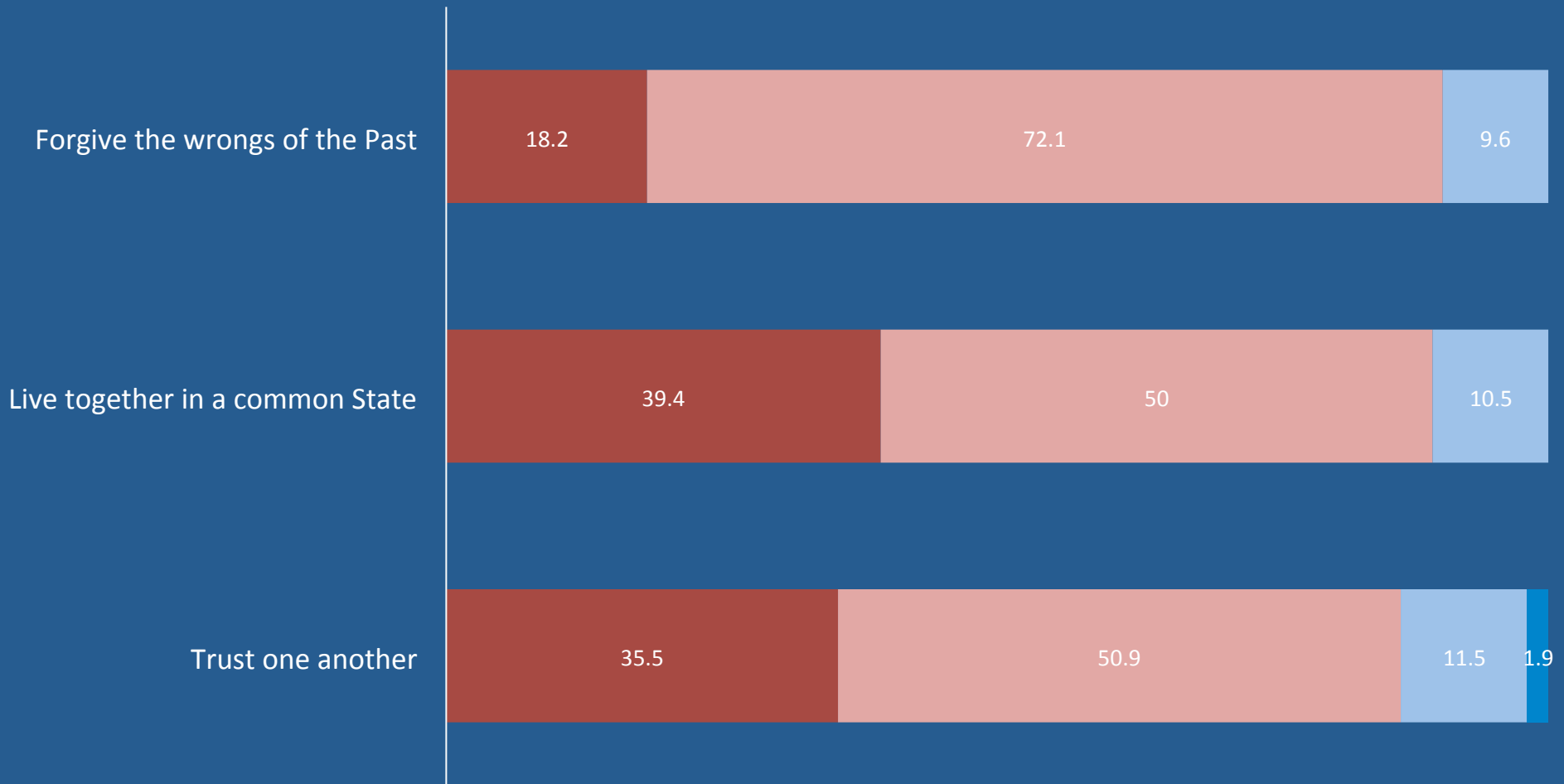
