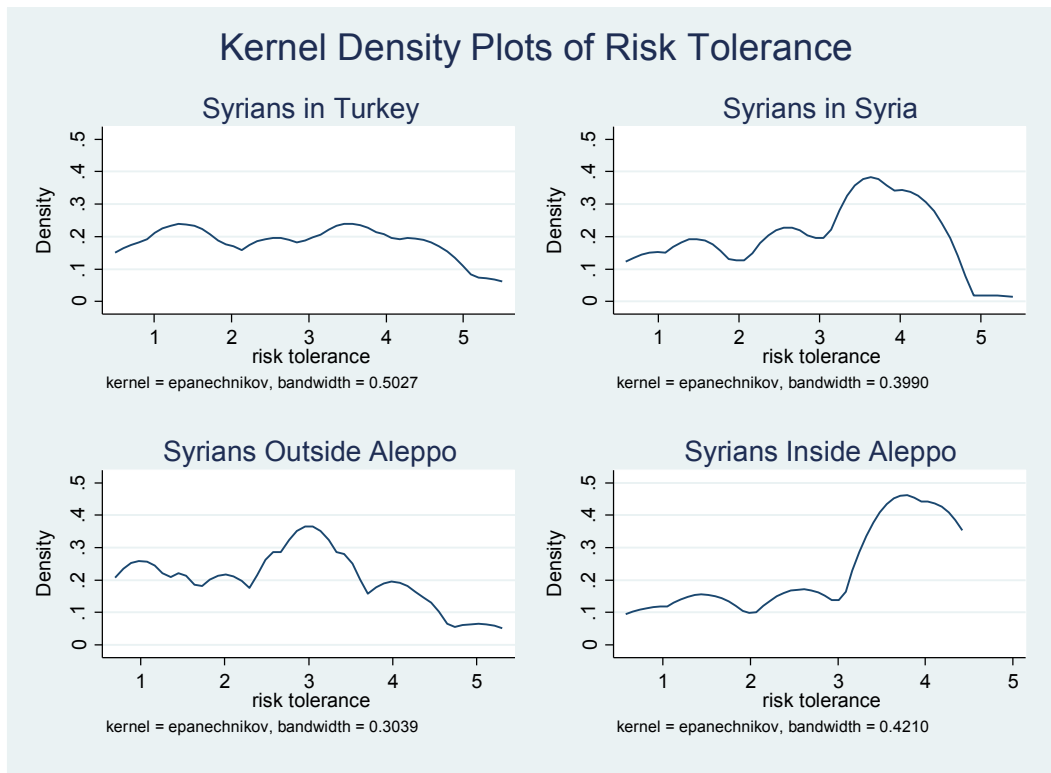


Figure 2. Risk Preferences for Civilians and Rebel Combatants in Syria (linear EG game)

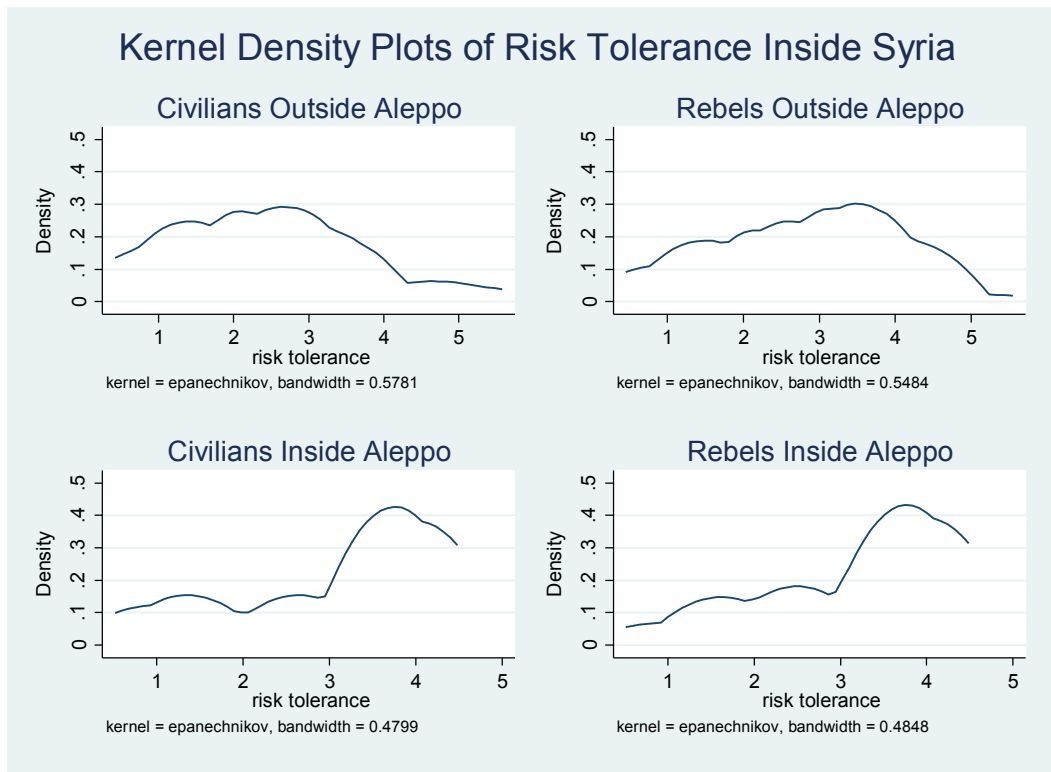
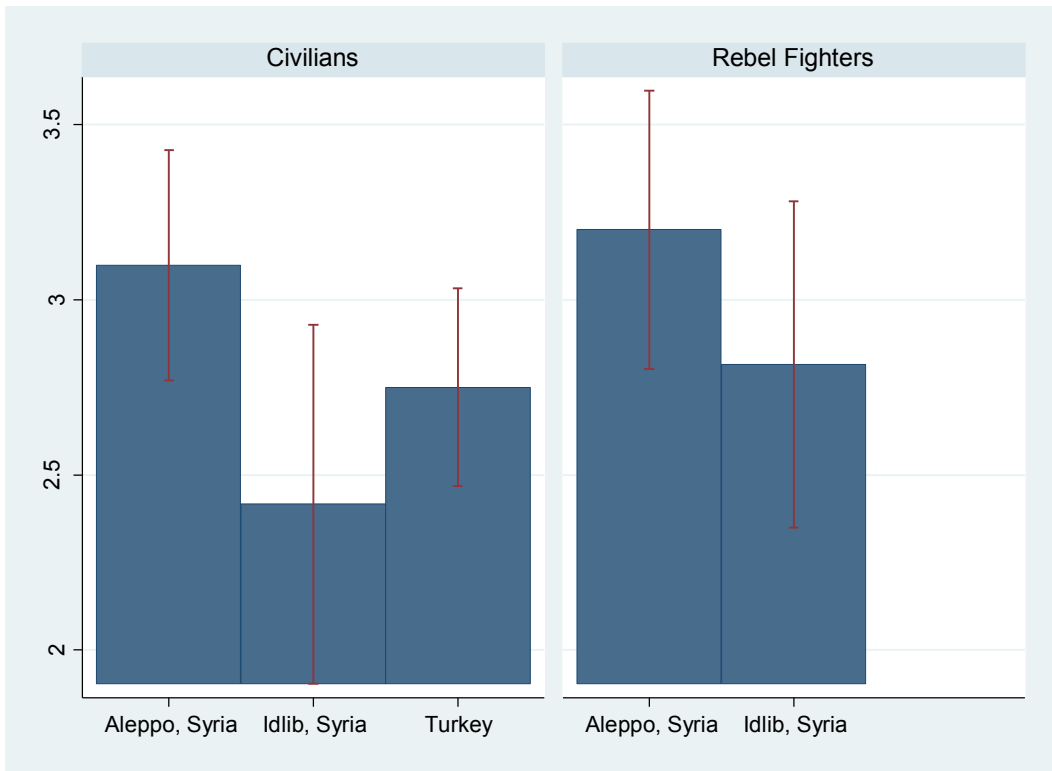
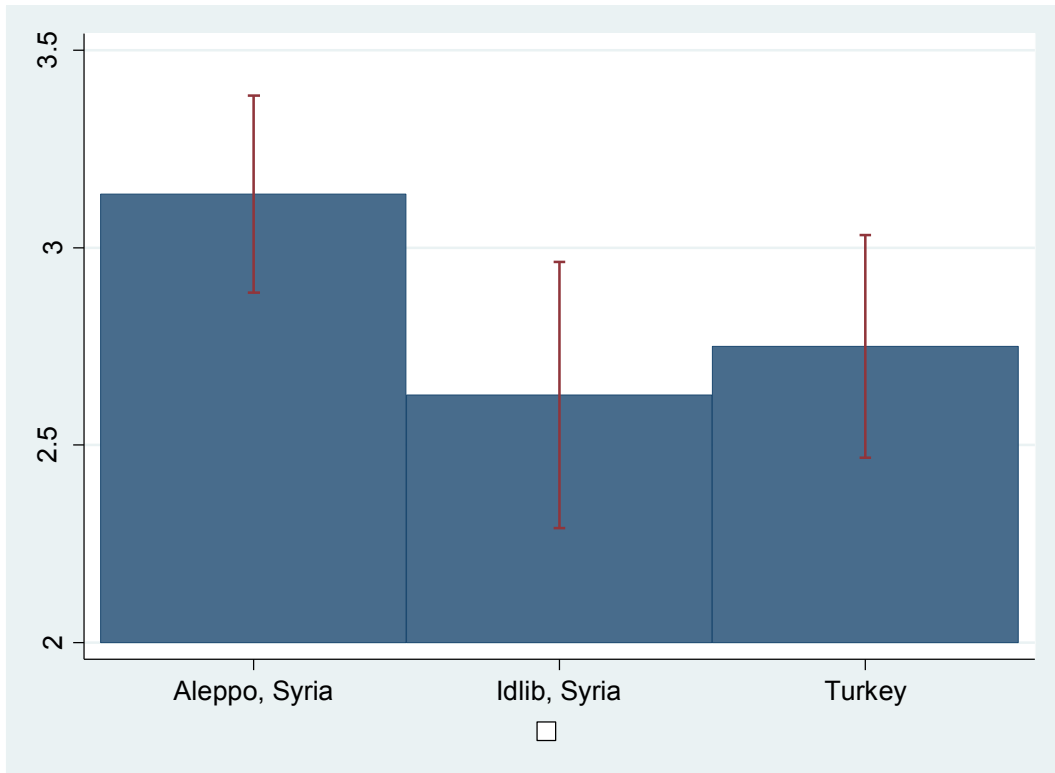


Figure 3 Mean Risk Tolerance (Linear EVs, 95% Confidence Intervals in Brackets)



**Figure 4. Frequency Distributions of Risk Tolerance (% choosing each Risk Game option)**

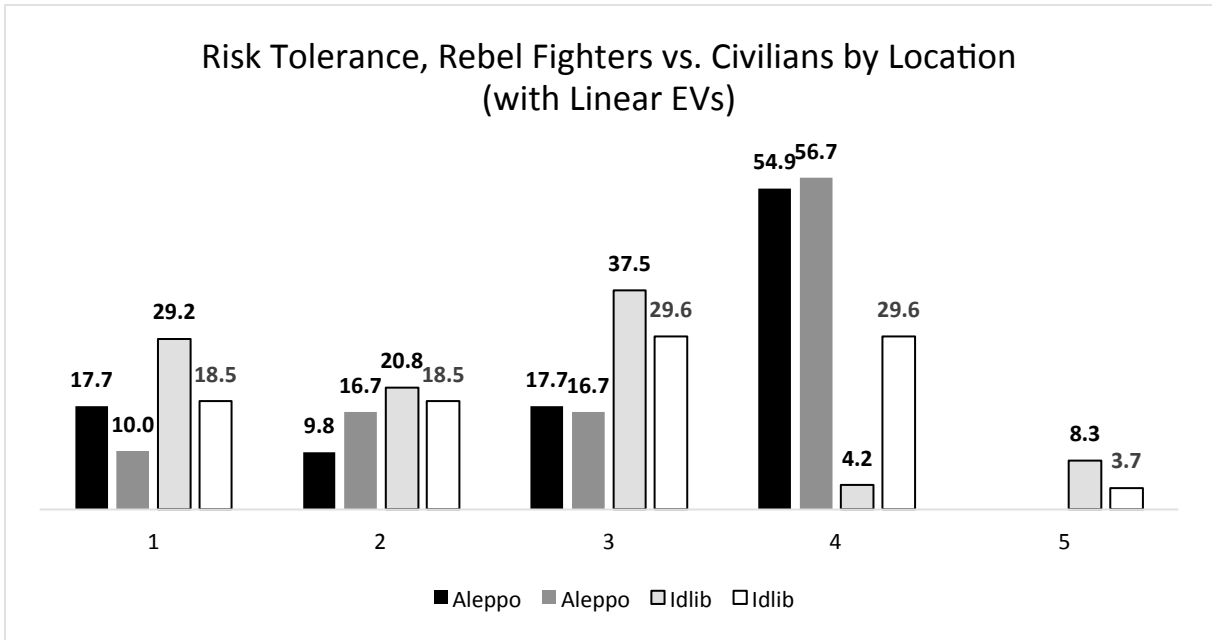
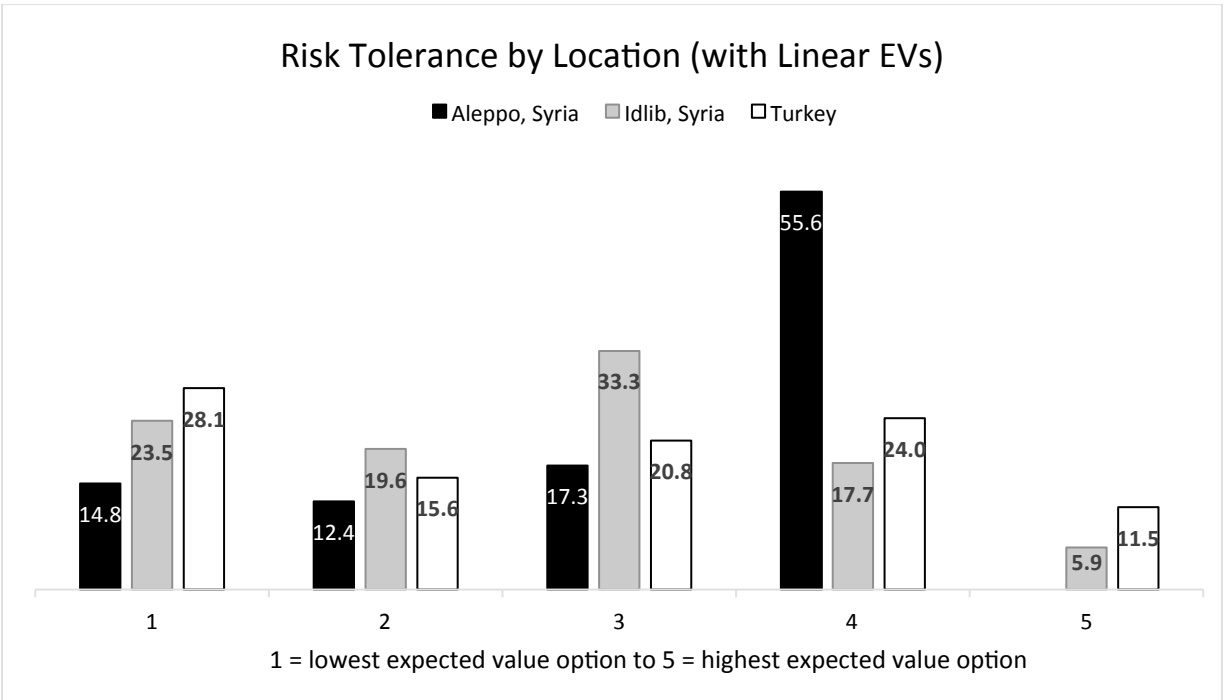


Figure 5. Areas of Rebel Control in Aleppo at the time of our study

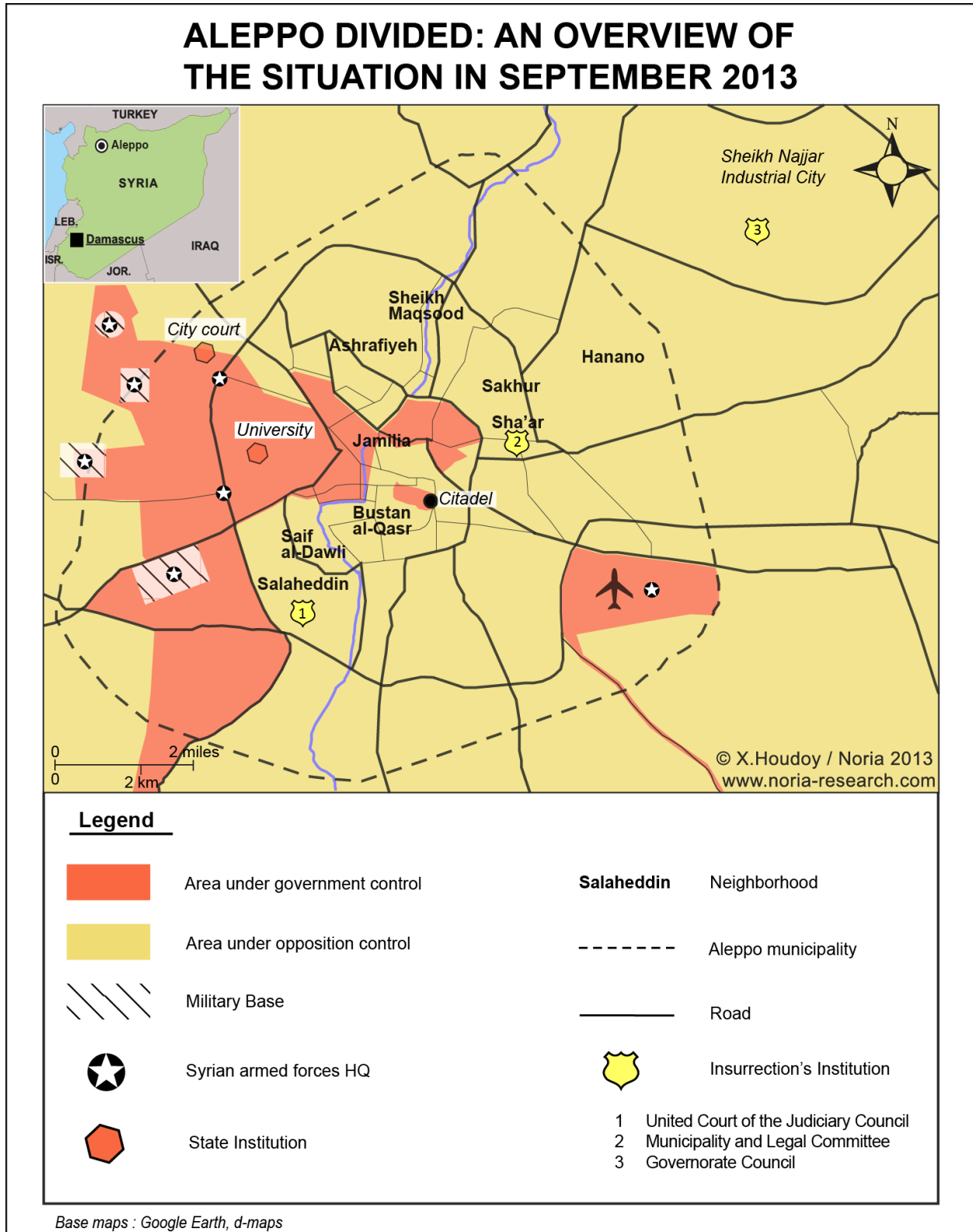


Figure 6. Sampling Locations in Aleppo

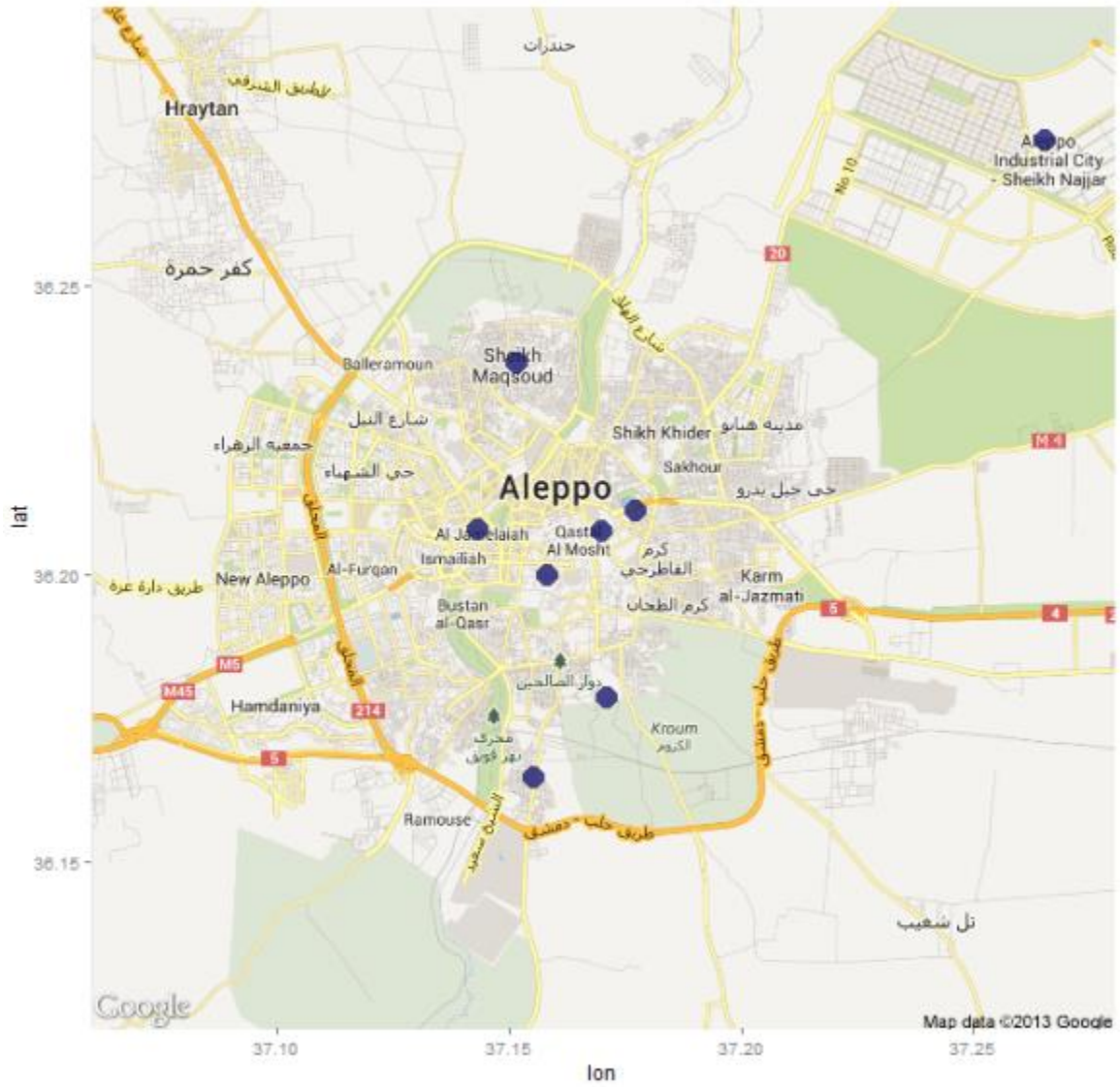
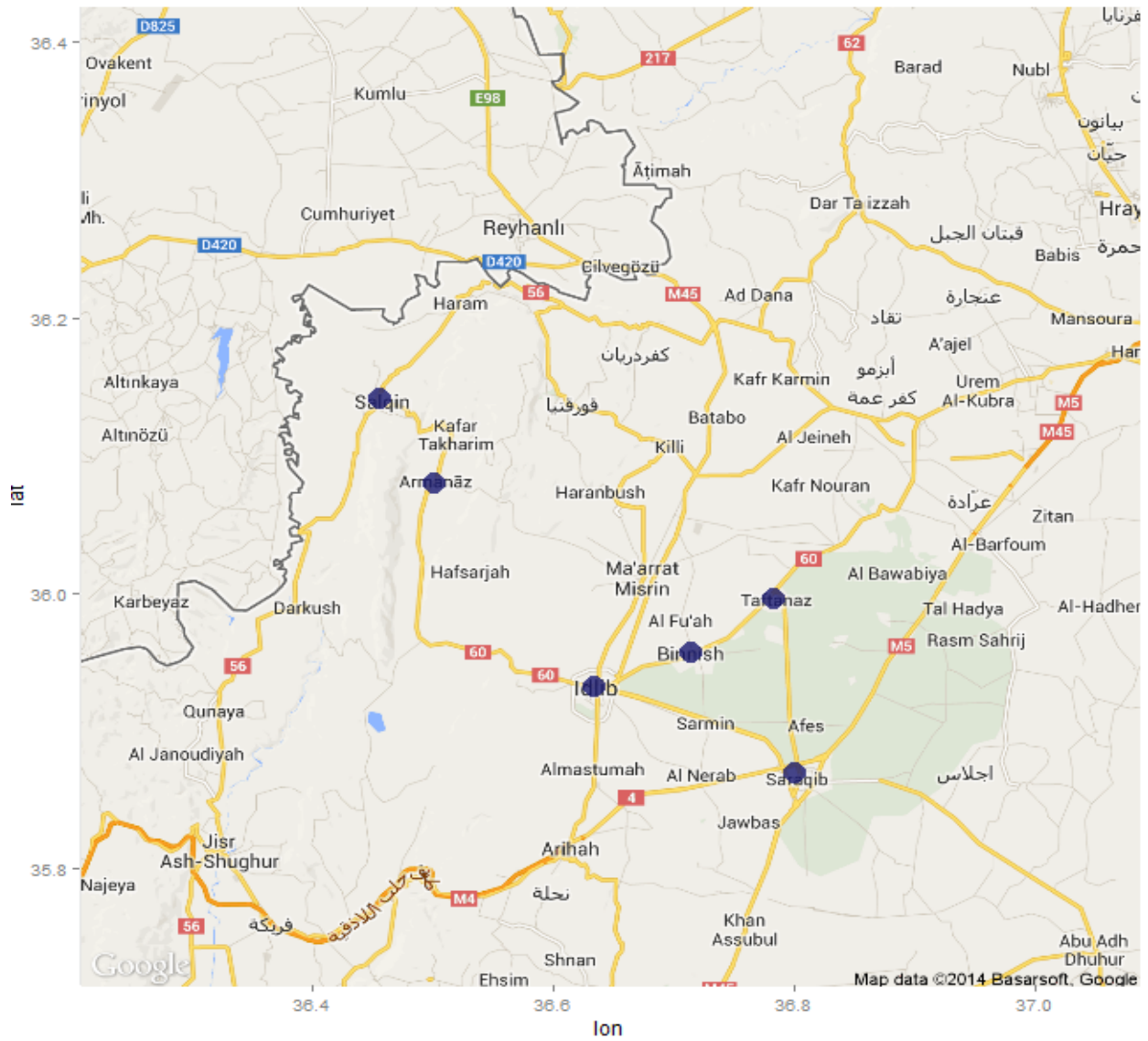


Figure 7. Sampling Locations In and Around Idlib
